

In the LOOP

MOUNTAIN VIEW
FILMMAKER CELEBRATES
PEOPLE'S STORIES

“Everybody has a great story to tell, but not everybody’s a great storyteller,” said Mountain View resident KimChi Tyler.

That’s where she comes in. While working for eight years as a journalist for CNN, Tyler dealt with TV personalities like Lou Dobbs and covered stories like Enron, Martha Stewart, the Scott Peterson trial and the Columbia shuttle explosion. Then she left all that in order to start her own company, Live Only Once Productions (LOOP).

Now, instead of TV celebrities, Tyler works for software engineers, doctors and kids, whom she thinks of as “ordinary people with extraordinary stories.”

LOOP, a completely novel business idea based on Tyler’s background as a journalist and documentary filmmaker, creates original documentaries for weddings, anniversaries, birthdays or any other special event to celebrate the stories of married couples, young children or beloved parents. Running 10 to fifteen 15, each film requires six weeks of interviews, research and editing to complete.

After accepting an assignment, Tyler begins the film production process by doing phone interviews with friends and family members. Tyler makes sure to get her interviewees comfortable so they have no qualms about opening up. “Before they even meet me we have fun on the phone,” she said.

“Later on, once they get comfortable,” she said, she comes to the house so that she and the client can have “a conversation with the camera rolling.”

Tyler transcribes all of the interviews. In addition, she sifts through tons of pictures, home videos and songs sent to her by the subject’s family. Taking everything into consideration, Tyler then writes a script, sends it to the client for approval, and then begins the video editing process. “It’s very, very involved,” she explained.

Because of the emotional nature of her documentaries, by the end of the process, Tyler said, “I’ve become their friend, or like part of their family.”

Prices depend on the amount of traveling required to complete each documentary and its run time. Tyler normally charges around \$4,000 for a shorter video and up to \$8,000 for an hour-long documentary.

Tyler sees a practical purpose in the service she provides. “When you fall in love, always the first question people ask is, ‘How

did you meet? How did he propose?”

Her videos answer such questions in an engaging, touching way. “The bride and groom can tell their life story. How they grew up and what shaped them and how they fell in love,” she explained.

Tyler’s fascination with biographies may be related to her personal struggle to find herself, a journey that she documented in her award-winning film “Chac.” Right before the fall of Saigon, Tyler relocated from Vietnam to Hawaii with her Vietnamese mother and American stepfather. Later she moved to Florida, where she was voted homecoming queen of her high school and eventually attended Florida State University.

In her film, Tyler returns to her homeland to seek out her biological father. She became closer with her dad as well as other relatives there, learning about their culture, her mother’s past and herself.

Tyler said that both “Chac” and the films she makes for LOOP are “about knowing where you came from, knowing how you got there and who raised you and who formed who you are today, and then passing that on to your children. It’s like preserving legacy.”

The final product always leaves the sub-

ject, family and friends astounded, Tyler said, and many of the viewers cry during the showing.

Tyler said that one bride told her, “Even though our wedding should be the center of attention, your video was the highlight, but we didn’t mind that because it was just so lovely.”

At the only clients’ wedding that she attended, Tyler received a standing ovation from the bride, groom and guests. “That kind of impact just makes me so happy,” she said.

The inspiration for her company came from her own friends’ weddings. “I go to a lot of weddings and I see a lot of slide-shows, and they’re very nice, but this is a step further that I can do,” she said. “I’m a biographer, I’m digging in. ... It’s very journalistically driven, which I don’t think consumers have access to.”

Small potatoes for the 'small entity'

INVENTORS SHOULD AVOID PATENTING PROCESS WHICH FAVORS BIG CORPORATIONS

The U.S. Patent and Trademark Office (USPTO) was established by an act of Congress, as mandated by the Constitution. For many years thereafter, models of an invention were required, and the emphasis was on small entities — that is, individual inventors.

Patenting has subsequently morphed into two separate and distinct branches. One branch still emphasizes small entities, but is now mostly used in other countries. The other branch, perceived as strongly favoring large entities — mainly corporations — is now the primary patenting method in the U.S.

Along with this change, the requirement for working models was discontinued, except in special cases such as perpetual motion machines. The reason often given is that many current inventions are too complex to model properly, but it is also true that large-entity patenting has become increasingly more abstract, and it is harder to know what to model.

Consequently, in this country the word "patent" usually refers to the large-entity, or "defensive," patent. Defensive patents are heavily favored by large companies such as multinational corporations, ostensibly because they are "broader," or protect against "unforeseen" applications of an invention. In fact there is little or no evidence that the defensive patent gives more protection, and a great deal of evidence that it often gives less protection, because it is so abstract.

The preference among large entities for the defensive patent is actually based on business strategy rather than any legal reasoning. Defensive patents cost a lot to litigate, so they heavily favor litigants with the most money. When less affluent litigants run out of money, they lose, right or wrong. For a closely related reason, defensive patents are often favored by patent professionals;

the pay is always better with large entities.

Individual inventors, by contrast, might apply for a "Jepson patent," named after a 1917 case, *Ex parte Jepson*. Jepson patenting (also referred to as "offensive" patenting, where the term implies an aggressive posture rather than disagreeableness) is relatively inexpensive to prosecute through the USPTO and to defend in court. In fact, with a carefully written Jepson patent, litigation may be avoided entirely, because the patent tends to be clear and unambiguous. Experts aren't needed, and juries unnecessary. Specialized (and extremely expensive) attorneys are no longer required — if the invention is clearly stated, any attorney will be able to handle the case.


Consequently, the Jepson patent should be strongly favored by small entities. Except for cases in which a small entity has joined forces with a large entity (in which case the combination is clearly a large entity) there is no reason for a small entity to even consider using defensive patenting. It may be hard to find a patent attorney who will prosecute (write and submit) a Jepson patent, but it will pay to keep looking until one is found; the protection is so much greater for the small entity.

It should be noted that at one time defensive patents were used by patent "pirates" to gain title to other people's patents. These pirates were technically small entities (with a lot of assets), leading to the idea that defensive patents are to be favored by small entities.

The USPTO and the courts have essentially stopped this type of piracy in recent years, and one could hardly defend that use of the defensive patent in any case. Larceny is not a proper goal of patenting. However, ideas die slowly, and there are still people who think the defensive patent favors small inventors. It doesn't.

The difference between these diametrically opposed patents is worth further examination. Next month, I will go into their specifics, and make a case for why inventors should pursue the Jepson patent. ■

A new kind of phone bill

When is it better to pay with your cell phone, rather than with cash, check or plastic?

Telephone companies and banks have been asking this question since 1993, when OP Bank in Finland first let customers do online banking from a mobile phone. There may be no better time than now, for U.S. consumers, according to some local startups.

Do you want to order a restaurant or takeaway meal in advance? MyTango lets you pre-order and pre-pay menu selections from your mobile phone from select restaurants and fast food outlets in Palo Alto, Redwood City, Menlo Park and Portola Valley. CEO Terry Erisman says, "The system works best for busy office professionals and students who don't want to wait in line for their lunch."

You fund your MyTango account from your bank account using the Web site www.mytango.com. MyTango is operated by Purveyant Corporation and is venture-funded by Atrium Capital.

Soon it will be back-to-school time, and there's no doubt your children will be asking you for cash. Redwood Shores company Obopay (www.obopay.com) makes it easy for parents to send money instantly all over the U.S. for allowances, dinner money and shopping trips using a mobile phone. Obopay has teamed up with Amp'd Mobile to offer services across college campuses. Your Obopay account

can be funded with a prepaid credit card, so no bank account is needed.

Howard Gefen, Obopay's EVP of marketing and sales, says, "With Obopay you can get, send and spend money anywhere." Anywhere in the U.S., at least.

(Disclosure: In 2005, Obopay, then called Ultralight FS, was a client of mine.)

Want to have fun at the supermarket checkout? A Palo Alto firm, iBrevia (www.ibreva.com), funded by Boston Capital Ventures, offers a slightly hokey solution: It aims to lower payment processing costs for merchants.

On registering, iBrevia sends a picture of a two-dimensional barcode image to a consumer's cell phone. I don't pay for multimedia texting, so when I signed up, I had to copy the image from my computer screen to disk, move it to my laptop and transfer it via infrared to my cell phone. Despite delays due to my cell phone software wanting to resize the image, it was the only system I could use within a couple of hours of signing up.

I went to pay at one of the three Portola Valley locations where it is installed. I entered

my PIN, held my phone in front of the scanner, and amazingly, it worked. I even went back to use it the next day.

Or why not use PayPal? With over 114 million worldwide Internet payment users, eBay's PayPal subsidiary announced a mobile service in April.

In fact, this is not the first PayPal mobile service. It unsuccessfully appeared on a few phone Web browsers in the past. Also, eBay applications are available. PayPal has a global brand and its mobile version can be used in the U.K. and Canada. However, there is a catch: PayPal's basic service won't work for Cingular's 56 million subscribers.

Meanwhile, watch out! Competition at the point-of-sale will be fierce. Contactless smart card technology is coming to the Bay Area embedded in plastic cards and mobile phones. Card readers are already installed at Giants Stadium and other locations where payment needs to be made quickly. This is what established payment vendors — Visa, Mastercard and banks — will choose. ▣

The engineer turned volunteer

Editor's Note: Leadership Mountain View (LMV) prepares adults who live or work in the city to take on a wide variety of leadership roles in the community. Sponsored by the Chamber of Commerce, the program guides 32 individuals through a nine-month program each year. Over 400 persons have graduated from the program since

it began in 1989. The profile below is one in a series that will run periodically to highlight the accomplishments of LMV graduates.

REY RODRIGUEZ

Rey Rodriguez, a graduate of the LMV Class of 1999, has an 18-year history with the city of

Mountain View, beginning as a landfill engineer at Shoreline Park. He then moved to the city's Public Works Department as a project manager.

Rey says he always wanted to do some type of volunteer work, but never found the time. Once he completed LMV, however, "there was nothing to contain me."

He eventually joined the LMV Council, and in 2000 joined the board for the Community Services Agency (CSA), for which he has held the positions of vice president, president, and most recently secretary.

Rey recognizes the value of volunteering; he did not come from a privileged background, and says he remembers how folks along the way gave him a chance. While he can't repay those people directly, he can "try to give to others that are less fortunate, and maybe make

a difference in their lives."

When asked how he would like people to participate in their community, his request is simple: "Contribute in a way suitable to your own experience and ability." Financial support is always welcome, he says, as is hands-on volunteering.

Rey concluded two terms on the CSA board this spring. He now plans to take six months to evaluate his opportunities and see where he'll volunteer next.

He credits LMV with getting him started in the world of volunteering. He further credits LMV with giving him the leadership training and confidence needed to stretch into leadership roles in this arena. ▣
