Flower power

MOUNTAIN VIEW
PHOTOGRAPHERS ZOOM
IN ON THE VERY SMALL

Imagine being a photographer and getting so close to your subjects that you forget what you're seeing.

A car becomes only the small swoop of chrome you're focusing on. The mysterious inside of a flower seems to be a grand stage sparkling with pollen footlights.

The technique is called macro photography, but through the lenses of Bob and Joy Rewick it can feel like abstract painting.

In their close-up floral images, they peer between petals and

delve into the canyons of orchids and irises, finding unexpected shapes and angles. They photograph flora from the side, the back, underneath.

The Mountain View couple consider this work abstract photography; they say one of the greatest compliments they can receive for their work is, "What is it?"

Many of the images have a representational feel. For example, a photo called "Aquatic Dancer" could be a radiant sea anemone, or perhaps synchronized swimmers in canary-colored bathing suits.

But Joy says she and her husband don't look for the familiar when they're out shooting away with their cameras in a verdant place, perhaps the Elizabeth

Gamble Garden in Palo Alto or Edgewood Park in Redwood City. Rather, they lose themselves for hours in the intimate views of nature.

"It's like meditation. You are literally inside the flower," she said. "When you're that close, it becomes abstract designs. You feel more connected to the world; you see what most people don't."

In fact, the pair take such an abstract view that they typically don't pay attention to what kinds of flowers they're photographing. Afterwards, they often don't remember the species in each photo.

A current exhibit of the couple's floral work at the Coyote

'Annie' a sure shot

She is brash and unrefined. He is handsome and thinks a lot of himself. She speaks her mind. He storms out of rooms in jealous rages. She cleans up nicely and looks stunning in ball gowns. He finds himself weak in the knees whenever she looks his way.

Sound like your last relationship? Not quite — try Annie Oakley and Frank Butler's torrid love affair. It's nice to know some things never change, no matter if it's the 1880s or the 21st century.

It's also nice to know that Irving Berlin's rip-roaring tunes — "There's No Business Like Show Business," "Anything You Can Do" — still hold the same appeal today as they did the first time "Annie Get Your Gun" wowed Broadway audiences in 1946.

Foothill Music Theatre has brought Annie and her beau back to the South Bay for some sharp-shooting, wild good times. The community college theatre troupe, under the direction of musical veteran Jay Manley, does not disappoint. The production, which opened last weekend at the campus' Smithwick Theatre, is full of beautiful singing, spectacular sets and lovely costumes.

Led by Jessica Raaum (Annie Oakley) and Byron Westlund (Frank Butler), the energy level remains high from start to finish. It's hard not to feel like you've magically been transported to the Wild West. The cast makes sure we have a good time despite the script's dated, sometimes offense dialogue. The story, a whimsical look at one of history's most intense love affairs, was written by Herbert and Dorothy Fields and revised in 1999 by Peter Stone ("Titanic," "1776"), in an effort to tone down the negative portrayal of Native Americans and women.

Stone does a good job of axing all the "Indian" references; however he still has our heroine coming across as a love-struck idiot. This is a real shame. When we first meet Annie, there is so much potential in this messy-haired chipmunk of a girl. We are rooting for her to keep her doe-eyed, independent charm.

Alas, this assertiveness all but evaporates the second Frank Butler tips his cowboy hat and grins. (The real Annie Oakley must be turning over in her grave.)

Annie's near-instant transformation into a bumbling buffoon is still maddening no matter how many times you've seen the show. Raaum's interpretation seems particularly clown-like. Thankfully she pulls out of the trance rather quickly with the cheeky "You Can't Get a Man with a Gun."

Annie goes on to win Buffalo Bill Cody's sharp-shooting match outside the Watson Arms Hotel. Frank comes in second and immediately begins to pout. The pout turns into a full-blown tantrum when Buffalo Bill (a cartoonish John Musgrave) announces Annie is going to be the star of his Wild West Show, an honor once held solely by Frank.

Needless to say, the competition heats up. But as those of us know who paid attention during high school history class, things don't end up sour for good old Frank and Annie. ■

'Brooklyn Boy' makes good

DONALD MARGULIES' INSTANT CLASSIC GIVES US THEATREWORKS AT ITS VERY BEST

After what seemed like a long hiatus in the wet-your-pants-funny department, TheatreWorks broke the mold when it opened "Brooklyn Boy" recently at the Lucie Stern Theatre in Palo Alto.

Let's get right to the point: Brooklyn never looked this good.

Chalked full of smart, fluid dialogue and characters we can easily relate to, this 2004 comedy-drama by Pulitzer Prize-winning playwright Donald Margulies ("Dinner with Friends") will amuse and delight you from the very beginning.

At first, we get the odd sense that we are watching a Neil Simon play. There are certainly more than a few similarities — a New York setting, stubborn Jewish men, snarky off-beat humor, autobiographical undertones. But as the action progresses, it becomes clear that what Margulies has here is distinctly his own. And it's fantastic.

"Brooklyn" is a character study more than anything else. These are tricky to do, and easy to disregard. But Margulies balances his work so deftly that when the end comes, it's a little hard to leave the world he's created for us onstage.

Eric "Ricky" Weiss (played by Victor Talmadge, who looks a bit like Michael Keaton circa the "Batman" years) is a middle-aged author who has finally made it to No. 11 on the national bestseller list. But good things, as Margulies reminds us again and again,

hardly ever go unpunished.

We meet Eric in a Brooklyn hospital room. He has come to tell his dying father (Ray Reinhardt) about his great achievement, but is met with indifference and ridicule.

Out in the hospital waiting room, he runs into a childhood friend (David Kudler) who he hasn't seen in more than two decades. The friend treats Eric like a rock star, and Eric chafes under the adoration.

And then we follow Eric back to Nina's place, where we learn that Nina (Pamela Gaye Walker), a writer herself, has grown tired of living in Eric's literary shadow and is divorcing him.

The show's setup is so simple: just three scenes per act. Yet veteran Bay Area director Joy Carlin expertly guides us through each snapshot of Eric's life and seamlessly ties the pieces together into a perfectly fitted jigsaw puzzle. Completing the visual is scenic designer Annie Smart's cool rotating set that has us constantly catching glimpses of Brooklyn's glittering cityscape.

The second act has Eric traveling to Los Angeles, where he's sold the movie rights of his book, "Brooklyn Boy," to a big Hollywood studio.

We know that we are in L.A. the moment we are introduced to Alison (Kristin Stokes), a young college coed whom Eric brings back to his hotel room after his book reading. This scene is quite possibly one of the best in the whole show. Stokes' over-the-top flirtation and Talmadge's obvi-

ous unease makes the exchange so much fun to watch.

Things get a little shaky after that. The action moves to the office suite of a high-power movie producer played by Amy Resnick, who needs to be reminded to use her indoor voice. Her screeching may be character development, but it sure grows annoying fast. And Craig W. Marker as Tyler Shaw, a self-centered screen actor, comes across as trying a bit too hard with his "Saturday Night Fever" routine.

The two-hour production goes by in the blink of an eye, which was probably intentional. Though "Brooklyn Boy" peters out slightly at the end — Margulies gets a little too serious in the home stretch — it's hard to quibble with such a good play. ■

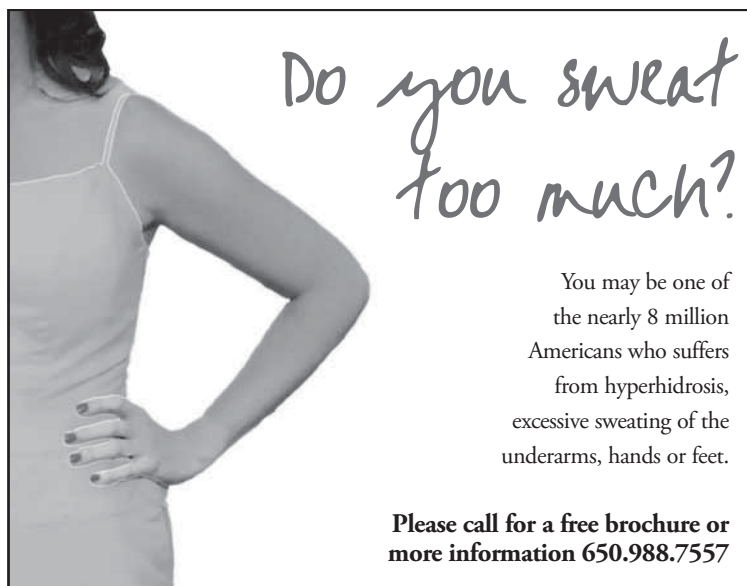

Point Museum in San Mateo is drawing appreciative responses, said Carl Oosterman, the museum's director of education. About 70 photos of flowers magnified two to three times line a hall facing expansive views of San Francisco Bay.

"It's a different way of looking at nature," Oosterman said.

The Rewicks are also exhibiting photos at Rengstorff House through August.

The two started getting interested in photography about 18 years ago, taking classes together at Canada College in Redwood City. It was an intriguing hobby to pursue outside of work — Joy works in the philosophy department at Stanford University, and Bob is a research scientist who was at SRI International in Menlo Park for 35 years and now is part-time at 3D Technology Laboratories in Sunnyvale.

The photography bug bit in earnest one day when the Rewicks were shooting buildings in San Francisco. They realized that using long lenses would add an abstract flair to their images, converging the background and making balconies melt into each other.

nies melt into each other.

Now their hobby has become a major endeavor. They have exhibited separately and together, and published photo essays in magazines. Bob also lectures on photographic subjects and judges in competitions.

In one of his essays, he advises photographers to "change the way you look at the flower" by seeing it as an art object rather than something to be documented.

"Slow down and give your eyes time to discover the myriad of creative angles, and points-of-view. ... Use flash as your light source to illuminate flowers from angles and ratios that are difficult or impossible to achieve with ambient light," he writes.

A room in the Rewicks' quiet condo is filled with neatly arranged cameras, lenses, filters, flashes, an old slide duplicator, a pinhole camera Bob made, and other equipment. On the wall, a periodic table of the elements presides over it all.

Bob picks up one of the hand-held cameras used to shoot flowers out in the field. He has attached two flashes, which protrude jauntily from the camera, as though on antennae.

"I avoid tripods, which is how most close-up work is done. They sink into the mud, you sink into the mud, the wind is blowing," he says. Tripods could also damage the natural surroundings, Joy adds.

Bob continues, "The flash freezes the motion, so you don't have to hold the camera as still."

Another camera has a bellows assembly that can be used to photograph things at three or four times their size, Bob says.

The two have shot with film for years and have been transitioning slowly into digital photography — which probably will happen in earnest once they use up all the film stored in the refrigerator.

Flowers are a fascination both

because of the Rewicks' love of nature and the fact that the subject gives them a niche as photographers, Bob says. In addition, Bob, who is also a beekeeper, has a penchant for bees, bugs and spiders.

"I did a close-up of a tarantula head and a black widow torso," he says, adding quickly, "all live."

Joy is also taken with close-up images of cars, creating what she calls "auto art." She flips through a binder of her photos, which include "Radiance," an image of a fancy hubcap that could be a tropical sunburst.

She says proudly, "You cannot tell what these are." ■
