Charles Bukowski, "Factotum" unspools the tale of alter-ego Henry Chinaski (Dillon). He calls himself a writer, but his life is more about hard living than putting pen to paper.

Chinaski's quest for self-destruction is an undulating bell curve, riding on a wing and a prayer and a tidal wave of cheap booze. When Chinaski falls for unemployed drifter Jan (Lili Taylor), it's a match made in derelict heaven — two luckless losers making a soulful connection based on little more than randy sex.

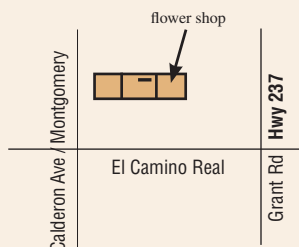

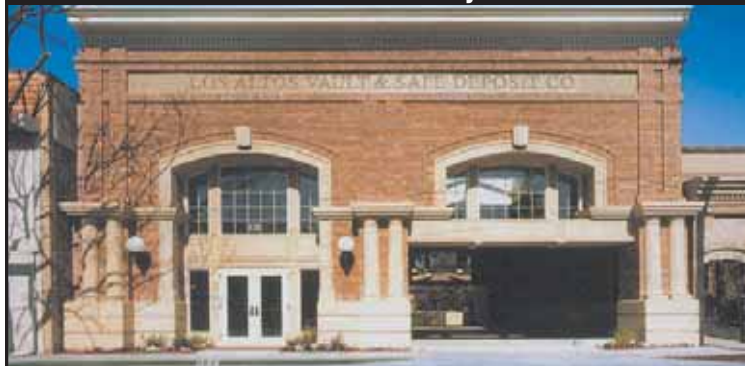

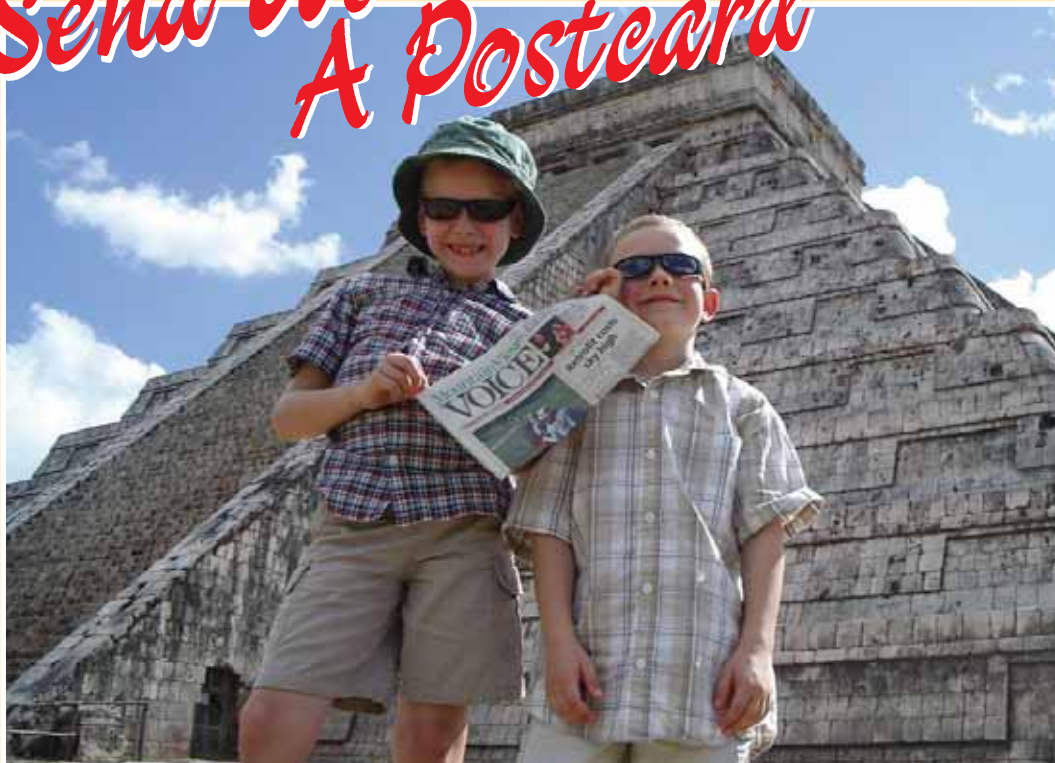

But Chinaski discovers more—a little more—to life when he makes it big at the racetrack and high-rolls his way into a job. Jan wants none of it and the relationship sours, putting Chinaski back on the streets. A chance meeting at a local bar nets him another adventure with perpetually stoned call girl Laura (Marisa Tomei), one of several mistresses of an eccentric millionaire.

A series of dead-end jobs and bouts of binge drinking are the foundation of onscreen shenanigans that become thought-provoking tales on paper. Dillon's voice-over captures some of Bukowski's most earnest prose, such pearls of wisdom as "If you're going to try, go all the way—otherwise don't even start," and my personal favorite, "Life grinding against death and losing."

Director Bent Hamer maintains the element of sleaze that made Bukowski one of his generation's most beloved scribes. The result is a depressing film of disenfranchisement that nonetheless manages to inject a gauzy glimmer of hope between sordid vignettes.

Minimal dialogue helps rather than hurts the cause, keeping it real with abstract intellect.

I dislike this genre, the kind that has me yearning for a shower to scrub off the scum. And I loathe the monotony of a lost soul embracing his inevitable descent to the bottom of a bottle. But with Dillon at the helm Bukowski's tale comes alive—chaotic and maddening, but eminently watchable. ▀

night, Dan is smoking away his future with the same brilliant intensity he brings to his work.

It's only a matter of time before one of his kids gets wise—and so she does, spying Dan in the girl's locker room with crack pipe in hand. The unsettling discovery by 13-year-old Drey (Shareeka Epps) is the improbable glue that bonds two lost souls together in a curious meeting of the minds: latch-key kid and crackhead trying to get it right.

Gosling's performance is a revelation, every bit as powerful as his outstanding turn as Jewish neo-Nazi Danny Balint in 2001's "The Believer." As Dan's half-baked evenings in questionable company intensify, the fissures of pain and resignation etch themselves on his face with potent subtlety.

Epps matches Gosling step for step with vulnerable adolescent dignity, the victim of a dead-end neighborhood and a deadbeat dad (Anthony Mackie) who wants back in her life for all the wrong reasons.

Players are sketched in sharp relief, strong and spare and reeking of latent self-destruction. Kudos to writer/director Ryan Fleck for keeping it real—no fairy-tale endings and no quick cinematic fixes. Great stuff. ▀



MOVIE REVIEWS

IDLEWILD ★★★1/2

(Century 16, Century 12) Percival Jenkins (Andre Benjamin) and lifelong pal Rooster (Antwan A. Patton) are living it up in the speakeasy days of Idlewild, Georgia. Percival joins the family business—a la "Six Feet Under"—while Rooster raises a large brood and tries to make ends meet with a side dish of bootlegging. Both unwind evenings at jiving nightclub Church, where Percival tinkles the ivories and Rooster performs a mean soft-shoe. The narrative is deliciously non-linear, weaving in plot threads and disjointed styles with vivid abandon. The action plays out against a backdrop of short-tempered gangsters and dirty money-laundering, most of it with a sociopathic heavy named Trumpy (an excellent Terrence Howard) leading the charge. "Idlewild" is not for everyone. It's frantic, chaotic and fantastically flawed, mixing rap, swing, hip-hop and blues with gimmicky commotion and a raging torrent of racial emotion. *Rated: R for extreme violence, nudity and profanity. 2 hours, 1 minute.* — J.A.

INVINCIBLE ★★★1/2

(Century 16, Century 12) Once again Mark Wahlberg plays a diehard fan—the archetypal working-class underdog with talent and even more heart—who makes it to the big time. Long-time cinematographer Ericson Core ("The Fast and the Furious") shows his skill as a utility player, making his directorial debut and shooting this story inspired by South Philly's Vince Papale. In 1976, Papale soared where Philadelphia Eagles dare as an NFL wide receiver and special-teams performer. Thirty-year-old Papale (Wahlberg) has lost his substitute-teaching job and his wife (Lola

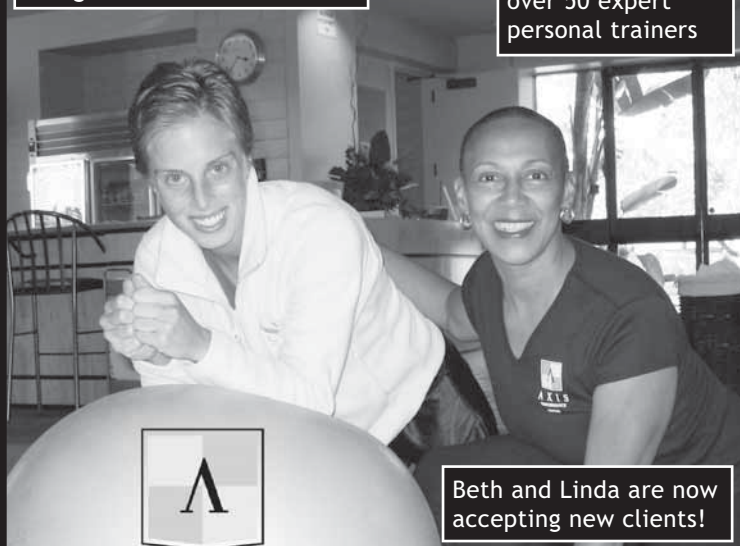

Glaudini). When the Philadelphia Eagles hire UCLA coach Dick Vermeil (Greg Kinnear), the newcomer makes a surprise announcement: open tryouts. Papale is a walk-on who takes all the emotional and physical hits from the players, coaches and Eagles fans. He keeps getting up for more until he makes the team against all odds — becoming the oldest rookie in NFL history, excluding kickers, without college football experience. Although "Invincible" sports every cliché in the inspirational playbook, this football drama's three-act structure still pushes your buttons and gets you to cheer

on cue. *Rated: PG for sports action and some mild language. 1 hour, 39 minutes.* — S.T.

LITTLE MISS SUNSHINE ★★★ (Aquarius, Century 20) The Little Miss in question is sunny 7-year-old beauty pageant hopeful Olive Hoover (Abigail Breslin), a darling dumpling whose cantankerous grandpa (Alan Arkin) is coaching her in pageant etiquette and a flashy talent number. Life is not a bowl of cherries in the Hoover household. Dad Richard (Greg Kinnear) struggles to get his shaky motivational speaking career off the ground, pushing his nine-step, no-excuses tutorial with forced brio. Mom Sheryl (Toni Collette) flutters mother-hen-like over an eccentric

brood that also includes Sheryl's brother Frank (Steve Carell), fresh from a suicide attempt over the loss of his gay lover. All systems are go when Olive unexpectedly nabs a spot in the penultimate Little Miss Sunshine competition, kick-starting familial frenzy. The gang is hastily packed into a last-legs VW van in Albuquerque, headed for the sunny climes of Redondo Beach, California. The ensemble acting is first rate, each and every player coming through with vibrant characterizations that mesh with thespian ease. "Sunshine" can be safely crowned a comic winner. *Rated: R for language and sexual content. 1 hour, 41 minutes.* — J.A.

SNAKES ON A PLANE ★★★ (Century 16, Century 20) Strictly B-movie but rocking with energy, "Snakes" is a minimalist action picture that goes all out to thrill, chill and spill — guts, that is. Samuel L. Jackson takes on the role of badass FBI Special Agent Neville Flynn, who boards Honolulu's Pacific Air Flight 121 enroute to Los Angeles with a young witness (Nathan Phillips as Sean) who happened upon a brutal murder and is headed to the mainland to testify. Economy class turns into hell with wings, courtesy of a cargo of venomous vipers strung out on pheromones, strategically placed on board to make sure our intrepid witness doesn't reach his date with destiny. Once the rapacious reptilians are unleashed, it's a gore-fest extraordinaire, each drippy moment more shriekingly blood-splattered than the last.
