## Where house meets nature

WITH A NEW BOOK OUT, MOUNTAIN VIEW'S LISA PARRAMORE BRINGS JAPANESE GARDENS TO WESTERN HOMES

In the midst of daily chaos, Lisa Parramore believes, Japanese gardens offer necessary moments of peace.

So inspired was she by the mastery of Japanese gardens, the Mountain View resident wrote a book on the subject, "Living with Japanese Gardens," co-authored by Chadine Flood Gong. In it she emphasizes the connection in those gardens between humanity and nature, and the peace that ensues from the relationship.

Parramore's professional life has taken many different paths; at this point, the most prominent aspect of it is her love affair with Japanese gardens. She even founded her own landscaping company, Hanabié Japanese Garden Design, which she runs out of her home.

It was on this path that she met co-author Gong, a Los Gatos resident who is also a landscaper and interior designer in the Japanese style.

"Gong and I first met when I hired her to landscape my backyard," Parramore recalled.

It's not just the exterior of Parramore's Old Mountain View home, where she has lived for 15 years, that contains Japanese touches. The tub in her master bathroom, for example, is designed to resemble the soaking tubs in Japan.

During the early 1990s, Parramore lived in Fukushima, Japan, while she taught for the Japan Exchange and Teaching Program. "My fondest memories of Japan are going skiing and then relaxing in the

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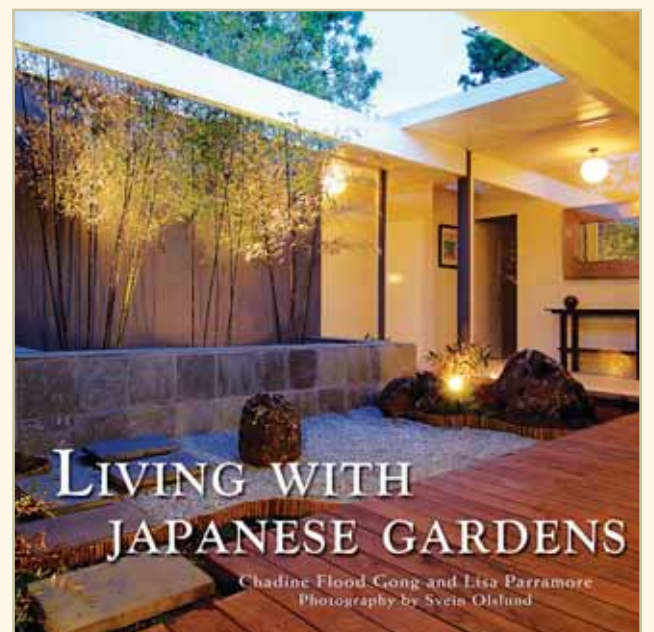

# Government-funded green

REBATES ARE SPURRING MANY HOMEOWNERS TO INSTALL THEIR OWN SOLAR ARRAYS

Green never looked so good. Solar panel installations have been growing at about 45 percent a year in California. Why? Is it the government rebates? The long-term value? The rising cost of energy? A desire to stop global warming?

The answer is all of these factors. The stars have aligned for solar power, and consumers are installing panels like never before. Unlike the systems used in the 1970s, which used the sun to heat water, today's most popular systems are photovoltaic (PV), producing electricity directly from the sun.

First, let's talk about the rebates. Between the federal government and state of California, a robust system of tax credits and rebates has been put in place, making California one of the most advantageous places in the country to install solar. On a typical residential system, approximately a third of the cost of the system is paid back in tax incentives and rebates. The California

Energy Commission gives a \$2.60-per-watt rebate. The federal government typically kicks in an additional \$2,000.

A typical three-kilowatt photovoltaic system that retails for about \$25,000 usually nets out at \$15,000 after rebates. On top of that there is the property tax exemption. Although solar panels increase the value of your property, the added value is exempt from county tax assessment. According to Bill Scott, of Akeena Solar, for every \$1 in annual energy savings you get from your new system, you can expect about \$21 in additional value to your home.

But that is just the beginning. Solar power generation starts to pull your electrical meter backwards during peak times of the day. With the recent passing of the Million Solar Roofs Bill, the state has mandated that utility companies must pay you for any excess energy they feed back into the grid. If you select a peak-demand energy bill, which charges different rates for energy depending on when energy is in greatest demand, the benefits grow. The utility pays for your energy at the highest rates — during the afternoon — which also happens to be when PV solar systems produce the most energy. Most working people utilize most

of their energy in the morning and night, which is sold at a lower, non-peak rate.

Solar power's coincidence with peak-power demands also provides another perk for our energy-hungry state. California's energy needs are highest during hot summer days due to air conditioner use. By providing power when the state's needs are highest, you reduce the chance of rolling blackouts and the need to build new power plants. Energy providers must provide energy capacity for peak use, which means typically some power plant capacity remains idle 95 percent of the time just to cover the 5 percent of peak-power needs. Solar panels reduce that demand.

Closer to home, solar panels are usually installed on the sunny south-facing roofs. These panels absorb the heat of the sun, providing shade on your roof during those hot summer days, cooling the house and reducing air conditioning costs.

Julie Lovins and Gary Fowler installed PV panels on their downtown Mountain View home. Their 1.8-kilowatt system is oriented toward the southeast, not the optimal south-facing direction. Still, the system produces enough power for all their household needs. In fact, on a typical year they produce enough electricity in the first six or seven months to offset their use for the entire year.

Solar panels are typically guaranteed for 25 years, but pay back in about 10 years. You get a least another 15 years of free power after your system has paid for itself.

With energy prices escalating and global warming on the horizon, these last years may be the most valuable.

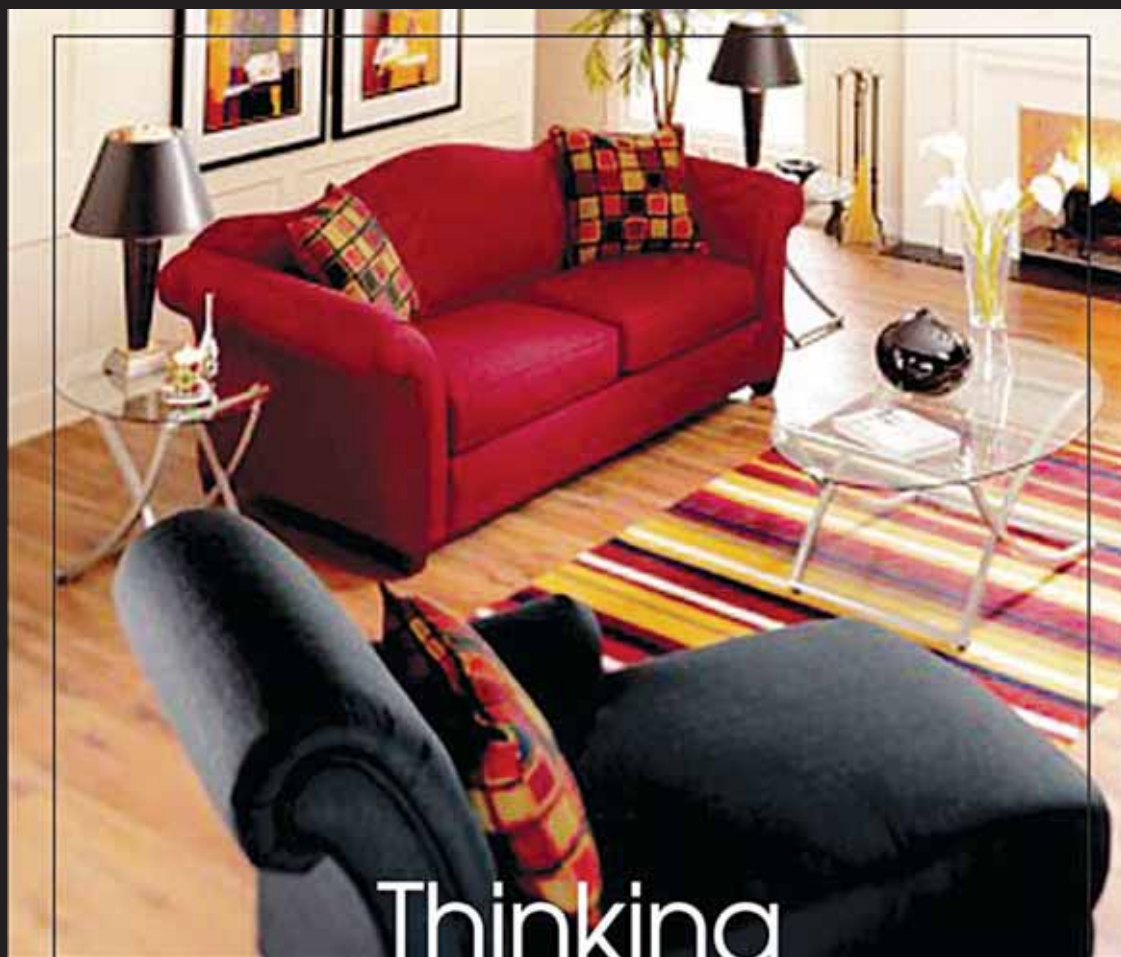
If you happen to own a commercial building, the rebates are better still, including an accelerated depreciation schedule and other rebates that provide system pay-back in about five to seven years.

Beyond dollars and cents, more and more people look at global problems stemming from society's reliance on fossil fuels and want to do something about it. In what used to be a partisan debate, people from all political perspectives are putting aside their differences and looking at the hard facts. Perhaps most important of these is the issue of global warming. The science is in: Global warming is caused by the burning of fossil fuels. The scientific debate is over.

Julie and Gary exemplify this issue. Although they are happy with their investment, saving money was not their primary motivation. As Julie put it, "We wanted to lessen our ecological footprint."

Although installing a solar system on your house will not solve all our fossil fuel problems, it is a personal step that can be done right now to help reduce global warming, air pollution and even wars. Maybe that is why the government is so eager to pay us to install them. ▀

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natural hot springs,” she said. Her Mountain View bathroom is modeled to mimic that effect, as though one were sitting in the hot springs.

Fukushima — a rural, unpopulated region of Japan known for its rice farming — inspired the bathroom in several other ways: A Japanese black pine can be seen through the window, and the curtain resembles the rice paper that is so common in Fukushima.

**Not just the dwelling**

According to the book, in the Japanese language, there are two characters that create the word for “home.” The first is “ka,” for house, and the second is “tei,” which translates into garden. A home in Japan is more than just the dwelling. The complete home is a combination of the house and garden.

In this spirit, Parramore says she seeks to bring an appreciation and integration of nature to the Western world. She hopes to bring a unity of house and garden through her writing and landscaping.

“Making the inside and outside

blend seamlessly is the hallmark of Japanese design,” she said. “Although traditionally people think gardens are meant to be enjoyed outdoors, I believe we can enhance the quality of life by creating avenues that can be enjoyed inside as well.”

If a reader were to take one idea or principle away from “Living with Japanese Gardens,” besides the idea of uniting the home and garden, Parramore hopes it would be the Japanese design principle of asymmetry. The asymmetrical design is unpretentious and unassuming, and Parramore finds it to be a refreshing alternative to Western symmetry. The book is full of beautiful colorful photographs

illustrating the concept.

Parramore works all throughout the Bay Area, particularly in Los Gatos, Palo Alto and Los Altos Hills. The climate here is much drier than in Japan, however, so some common plants in Japanese gardens must be substituted with others more adaptable to the region.

Parramore noted that the Japanese gardens in San Jose, for example, use pine trees, which require less water. She also noted that Japanese maples do grow well in California, and though they don’t grow quite as large, they are still very attractive, and therefore

are commonly used in the gardens.

Meanwhile, moss, a Japanese garden staple, is difficult to grow in dry climates. Here it is often substituted with Irish moss, Scotch moss or baby tears, none of which actually belong to the family of true moss.

"I prefer to use baby tears for ground cover. It is my favorite plant to use," Parramore said.

Local gardeners can discuss these and other tips during next week's book signing of "Living with Japanese Gardens" at Books Inc. on Castro Street. The event, which will include a talk by the authors, is on Thursday, Sept. 28 at 7:30 p.m.

Twenty-five percent of the event's proceeds will be donated to the Mountain View Educational Foundation (MVEF). The foundation provides funding for artistic, musical, physical and technological enrichment programs for the elementary and middle schools in the Mountain View Whisman School District.

Parramore's two young children attend Castro, and Parramore says she wants to contribute to a well rounded education for her children and their peers.

"The MVEF plays an important role in supplementing what the school district already provides. I am happy to be able to contribute to their cause," she said. ▀

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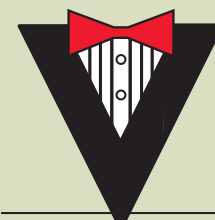

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

## STEERING PROBLEMS

Beyond these items, the power steering box or rack or power steering pump may be bad, in which

case repair or replacement is required.

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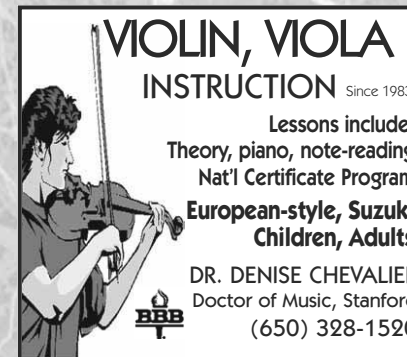
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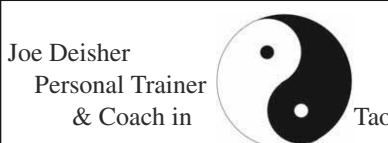

## Uniform Complaint Procedure

### Title IX Violations, Discrimination and Harassment.

District programs and activities are free from discrimination and harassment, with respect to ethnicity, religion, gender, age, color, race, ancestry, national origin, sexual orientation, marital or parental status and physical or mental disability. The board desires to maintain an environment in which all students and adults are treated with dignity and respect. No student shall be subjected to sexual overtures or conduct either verbal, visual, or physical, which are intimidating, hostile, offensive, or unwelcome. Such conduct by adults or students is deemed unacceptable and will not be tolerated by the school district. (EC 48980)

The board prohibits intimidation or harassment of any student by any employee, student or other person in the district. Students who harass other students shall be subject to appropriate counseling and discipline, up to and including expulsion. (BP 5145.3)

The Board ensures equal opportunities for all students in admission and access to the educational program, guidance and counseling programs, athletic programs, testing procedures, and other activities. Eligibility for choral and cheerleading groups is determined solely on the basis of objective competencies. School staff and volunteers carefully guard against segregation, bias and stereotyping in instruction, guidance and supervision. However, separate provisions may be made for students according to sex with respect to such matters as protection of modesty, family life and sex education, grading standards in physical education, and choral groups.

The district follows uniform complaint procedures when addressing complaints alleging unlawful discrimination based on ethnic group identification, religion, age, gender, color, or physical or mental disability. All complaints will be handled in a professional manner, and complainants are assured of non-retaliation and non-retribution.

Any person who wishes to discuss or file a complaint based on discrimination or harassment should first seek remedy through the office of the school's principal. Depending on the nature of the complaint and/or if the complainant feels that the issue has not been satisfactorily resolved, a written statement may be filed with the principal and a copy sent to the Associate Superintendent for Educational Services. If the issue cannot be resolved at the level of the principal, a formal complaint should be filed with the District's Title IX compliance officer, the Associate Superintendent for Educational Services Brigitte Sarraf. After a complaint has been duly investigated and if the complainant is dissatisfied with the District's decision, the complainant may file a written appeal with the Board of Trustees or the California Department of Education within 15 days of receiving the District's decision.

If the complainant is unable to put a complaint in writing due to conditions such as illiteracy, language barriers, or other handicap, district staff shall help him/her to file the complaint.

Complainants may pursue other remedies, including actions before civil courts or other public agencies. Complainants may seek assistance from agencies such as legal assistance, local mediation centers or from private attorneys.

Any individual, public agency or organization may file a written complaint of alleged noncompliance with state and federal law. The complaint must be initiated no later than six months from the date when the discrimination is alleged to have occurred or when the complainant first obtained knowledge of the facts of the alleged discrimination.

**Complaints regarding school procedures, practices and personnel.** Complainants are encouraged to resolve complaints against school personnel through informal means by talking directly with the school person involved. If this is not successful, a written complaint may be directed to the employee's administrative supervisor or principal. Appeals from administrative determinations or decisions may be taken up with the Associate Superintendent of Personnel, who will make decisions on these matters. After consultation with the superintendent, any patron may address the Board of Trustees at a regular meeting.

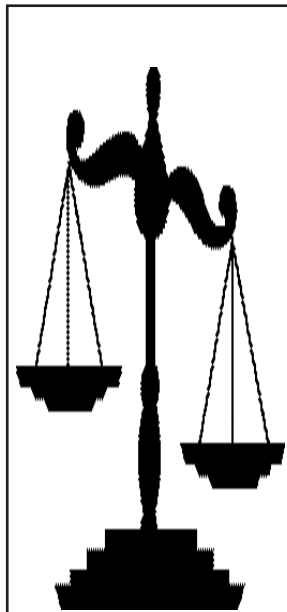

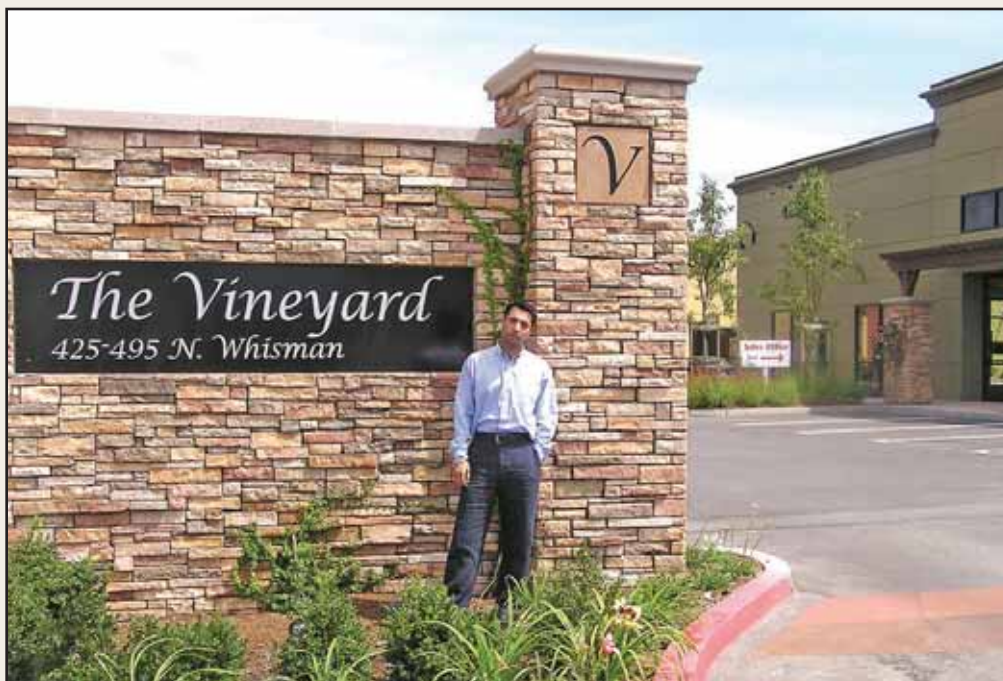
