Class from the past

PENINSULA DESIGNER ROUNDS OUT
'BOUTIQUES ON BRYANT' WITH RETRO CHIC

The mannequin wears a clingy black shell, topping a black-and-silver, slender-silhouette skirt, as she poses next to a martini cart. The vignette looks more like an ad for a '50s magazine, rather than window dressing for Vian Hunter, a new women's boutique at 520 Bryant St. in Palo Alto that opened in early November.

Owned by Lisa Vian Hunter and her husband Scott Hunter, the shop features an array of designs by Lisa, inspired by fash-

ions from the '50s, '60s and '70s.

"I grew up looking at Vogue and Bazaar," Hunter said, pointing to the framed magazine covers above the retro, semi-circular couch in the shop.

Less than two weeks after opening, the shop is filled with her signature pieces — simple, elegant, feminine. Hunter even names her dresses. Her current favorite is "Kimberly," a loose-fitting Italian wool double-knit jersey, cut to mid-knee, available in red or black. But then there's "Beverly," a cotton-wrap gray

and black print, reminiscent of Diane von Furstenberg's early work.

"Little Black Dress," a sleeveless wool (lined in silk) dress with French darts and a fitted waist, features one large pleat in front. "Holly," a one-shoulder, black wool jersey "would be fabulous with a brooch on the shoulder," she said. It's an empire cut, so it will fit most bodies, she added.

Hunter flits from "Rosie" — a silk brocade with Duchess-satin skirt, fitted through the hip, then flared "a la Balenciaga" — to a full-cut denim jacket, gathered across the back, with pockets. Or a simple black sheath cocktail dress, topped with a separate overskirt, also with pockets.

Most of Hunter's dresses and

skirts sell in the \$100-\$500 range, with many at about \$300.

Occasionally, she will take custom orders. "We're so new, we're still feeling our way," she said, adding that her goal was to create ready-to-wear items.

At first she imagined designing for 40-somethings, like herself, but she's found her pieces have appeal for everyone from her 74-year-old mother to her 20-something intern.

All, she hopes, will be attracted to "the glamour, the beauty. Look at the models. They're so pretty," she said. Her goals are to create feminine fashions — pretty, not fussy — skirts that move, in beautiful fabrics that make people feel good, she added.

In addition to her designs, Vian Hunter carries accessories, including Lucite and Swarovski crystal jewelry with plenty of bling (including wide cuffs and giant hoops), Beth Springer hand-

made purses in clamshell and envelope shapes, and Australian fur felt hats by Helen Kaminski.

"I don't like fuss. You're not going to find a whole lot of lace here," Hunter said.

Often she starts with ideas for dresses that are too simple to find in a department store, she said. One source for her inspiration is a recent \$6 find — a 1963 Vogue pattern book — happily

discovered at the Friends of the Palo Alto Library used-book monthly sale.

"These dresses — they are amazing," she said, pointing to the pattern book. She also keeps her eyes open for vintage patterns and old magazines. Her inspiration board is dotted with photos of rock stars that she took when worked previously as a photographer for a magazine, and snippets of fashion drawings taken from old ads in newspapers or magazines.

Although Hunter was always fascinated by fashion, she was too daunted when she graduated from Palo Alto High School in 1982 to study at San Francisco's Fashion Institute of Design Merchandising.

Instead she went to Foothill

College, then to work in retailing at Nordstrom's. That's where she met her husband, who was managing the fur salon there for Evans Furs, a Chicago family business.

Vian Hunter isn't the couple's first foray into business together. From 1994 to 1999 they ran Rocklove, a music magazine, where Lisa was chief ad rep and photographer. When they failed to get enough funding to push the project to the next stage, she turned back to her first love: fashion design.

At that point, she was 20 years older, married with two children; this time she could feel the excitement rather than fear.

"I had no clue what I wanted to do," she said, noting that her favorite place at the Fashion

Institute was the library where they had vintage Vogue magazines. Although she focused on “tween” design while at school — her daughter was 8 to 10 years old at the time — she knew she wanted to do women’s fashions after graduation.

Hunter and a friend then set up a business, Custom Fashion Design, which required many fittings to create the perfect dress. When that business fizzled, she took a break from design to care for Scott’s aging grandfather. After his death, she started seriously “designing summer dresses at a snail’s pace” while looking for a retail space in Palo Alto. The Bryant Street space became available, and suddenly she and Scott had three months to prepare a fall/winter collection and launch their boutique.

Today, Lisa is the designer and production manager, coordinating daily with pattern makers and cutters in San Francisco,

while Scott focuses on selling the clothes. At first, she designed in sizes 4 through 14, but she’s already expanded to 0 through 16, and plans to add petites next year.

Around the corner and up the stairs is her design studio. Often she begins with fabric, purchased in Los Angeles in small quantities. Once she figures out what to do with it, she’ll have one design made up in size 8; if she likes it, she’ll order more fabric, contact the pattern maker, and set the manufacturing process in motion.

Vian Hunter is the latest boutique to open on Bryant Street, between University and Hamilton avenues, joining Yasmin Deluxe Couture (shoes), Charmosa (swimwear, sweaters and sportswear), Bloom Butik (women’s, children’s and men’s clothes) and Gitti’s Fine Lingerie. The five shops have recently formed an association,

Boutiques on Bryant, and plan to offer cooperative makeover events, fashion shows and poetry readings. The purpose is to draw attention to the block, which what one customer said felt “just like New York.”

Hunter calls herself “fashion designer by day, Star Wars Legowoman by night.” In addition to launching the new boutique, she’s still spending time with her kids, including managing her 13-year-old daughter’s social life.

“While assembling Legos, it gets my mind off everything else,” she said. ▀
