Avenidas collaborates with new neighbor

ELDER CARE GROUP'S WINTER FITNESS CONFERENCE TO BE HELD AT MOUNTAIN VIEW SENIOR CENTER

Almost a year to the day after the Avenidas Rose Kleiner Senior Day Health Center opened at Escuela Avenue and Villa Street, another airy new facility for seniors opened right next door.

Now the Mountain View Senior Center and the Senior Day Health Center share a parking lot and a common purpose: senior health and well being.

Next month, for the first time, this common purpose will be on display as Avenidas holds the premier of its Winter Fitness Conference, designed to promote senior fitness, at its new neighbor's world-class facilities. At 25,000 square feet, the Senior Center

is much larger than any of the Avenidas facilities and can house more seniors for the conference.

The group is taking sign-ups now, and encourages more Mountain View seniors (age 50 and up) to attend. As of last week, organizers said, only one of the 65 seniors signed up for the conference was a Mountain View resident.

"The event is convenient for Mountain View residents," said Kari Martell, director of marketing and communications for Avenidas. "It will be a really great experience for them if they sign up."

The Winter Fitness Conference is a one-day camp modeled after the week-long Summer Fitness Camp held at Avenidas' main senior facility in Palo Alto. The

conference will cover all avenues of health, from mental to emotional to physical, and includes lectures and physical activities. All events are scheduled to be indoors in case of inclement weather.

Throughout the Jan. 27 conference, there will be three sets of three classes that the seniors

can choose from. The morning will open with a choice from of T'ai Chi, Hatha Yoga or Shaman Drumming, followed by a healthy lunch that includes a vegetarian option.

The second part of the day offers an option of interactive lectures and sessions from "Be

Sweet to Your Feet," "Good Fats/Bad Fats" and "Engaged Healing." Then more fitness sessions are offered, including "Strong for Life," "Line Dancing for Health and Fun" and "Dayan Qigong."

Each activity can be modified for seniors with physical restrictions so that no one is left on the sidelines. Many participate while seated or will remain in their wheelchairs and clap their hands, said Mary Lewis, a Palo Alto resident and participant of the Summer Fitness Camp for the last five years. Lewis was also one of the first to sign up for the Winter Fitness Conference.

"The program brings a sense of camaraderie because we are

NovaSure procedure gains in acceptance

CMG DOCTOR OFFERS
IN-OFFICE TREATMENT
TO REDUCE HEAVY
MENSTRUAL BLEEDING

Menorrhagia — a condition marked by severe menstrual bleeding — currently affects 10 million women in the U.S., or about one in five women.

However, over the past few years, a treatment for this condition has gained popularity. NovaSure has been available in the U.S. since 2002, and is finally gaining popularity among women and doctors.

Even though the number of afflicted women is already high, "This is perhaps a bigger problem than we are aware of," said Dr. Katherine Sutherland, an OB/GYN at El Camino Medical Group. "Many women are too embarrassed to discuss the issue with their doctors."

Menorrhagia usually occurs or worsens after giving birth. The condition is not necessarily life threatening, but it certainly can affect lifestyle, since afflicted women are often restricted to the home for fear of accidents. In extreme cases, loss of blood can lead to anemia, so women with menorrhagia can suffer low energy or depression.

According to many medical professionals, NovaSure is the solution: a quick, safe and effective ablative procedure that cures abnormal menstrual bleeding. After local anesthesia, a pen-like instrument is inserted in the uterus and secretes a gold mesh that covers the entire uterine wall. The mesh burns the lining, and then the system registers completion and turns itself off.

In all, the procedure takes about five minutes. There are no hormones involved, and recovery time is less than 24 hours with very little pain.

all in the activities together," said Lewis. "I wouldn't miss it for the world."

"We are excited for the opportunity to host this event," said Lauren Merriman, the senior recreation coordinator at the Senior Center. "The organization has been exhausting because of the different sessions, classes and rooms that are needed to pull off the event, but it is well worth it."

Sutherland says she has performed it more than a hundred times, and that she's pleased with the outcome.

"They can be performed in the office, which is much less invasive than going to the hospital," she said. The success rate with NovaSure in the reduction or cessation of bleeding is reportedly about 97 percent.

Other options to stop uterine bleeding include hysterectomies, which remove the entire uterus, and hormone therapies such as IUDs that contain progesterone. The IUD, called Mirena, lasts four years but must be replaced thereafter. Periods will get lighter but they will not completely stop. Birth control is also an option, and there are a few other endometrial ablation procedures on the market.

However, Sutherland said, "Because the NovaSure procedure is easier to do, it is moving up on the list of possibilities. It used to be the last resort before hysterectomies."

Sutherland notes that women who plan to have children in the future should not have this procedure performed. Also, no more than one endometrial ablation procedure can be performed on a woman. Also, NovaSure can't be done on women who have had a myomectomy, a procedure that removes uterine fibers.

"The most important thing to consider before having the NovaSure procedure is to know the cause of bleeding," Sutherland said. "You must first make sure that the bleeding isn't the result of cancer or another serious disease."

Merriman noted there are key differences between the two centers. The Senior Center is for independent seniors, while the Day Health Center is meant for seniors who are less dependent due to mental or physical impairments.

Directors of both centers say they're hoping to continue this collaboration, and plan to hold a weekend conference in Mountain View during the summer months. ▀

THOUGH TREATMENTS ARE SIMPLE, FEW AMERICANS SEEK HELP FOR VARICOSE VEINS

Q: How are varicose veins formed?

A: The veins in your legs have a huge job in pumping blood back up to the heart. In both the deep and superficial veins, there are valves that prevent backflow. Normally, blood flows up the superficial and deep veins on its journey back to the heart. When valves weaken and malfunction, the blood collects in the superficial veins, resulting in swollen, bulging veins.

Q: What are the risk factors for developing varicose veins?

A: The risk factors include heredity, obesity, aging, menopause, and having a job that requires a lot of standing. A leading factor for women is being pregnant, particularly in the last trimester. The more children you have, the greater the likelihood you'll develop varicose veins because of the increased burden on your circulatory system.

An estimated 15 percent of all men and more than 30 percent of women have varicose veins. Twenty-five million Americans have varicose veins, though only one million seek treatment, even though the condition has chronic symptoms.

Q: Can varicose veins be life threatening?

A: Varicose veins won't kill you. The swelling in the veins are not blood clots (which can travel from one part of the body through the circulatory system to another part of the body). While varicose veins aren't peril-

ous, they are chronic and can cause ongoing and escalating discomfort. Left untreated, varicose veins can cause venous ulcers, which can become acute.

Different from varicose veins, a patient can suffer from Deep Vein Thrombosis (DVT). In this condition, blood clots can form in the large veins of the body (in the legs and chest). DVT is one of the most prevalent cardiovascular conditions in the U.S. and poses serious risks including blood vessel and tissue damage, lesions and ulceration, and possibly death.

If you have varicose veins, particularly if they are painful and bulging, you should be examined by a vascular expert.

Q: What are the best treatments available for varicose veins?

A: It may sound too simple, but some of the most effective treatments are compression stockings and elevation of the legs. Compression stockings put pressure on the legs, greatest at the ankle and slowly decreasing up to the knee. The compression helps the vein valves keep the blood flowing up, reducing the collection of blood in the veins. Before patients undergo surgery, I recommend that they wear compression stockings for at least six months. It improves their vein condition as well as their success rate with the surgery.

Surgical options are better today than ever. We are having enor-

mous success with radio frequency ablation, or RFA. This innovative procedure is far less invasive than vein "stripping," the previous standard treatment. Nearly all patients are back to their normal activities within one day, with minimal bruising or discomfort. The radio frequency essentially closes the vein, and the body reroutes the blood to healthy veins.

Q: I've spent thousands of dollars — not covered by my insurance policy — to get rid of spider veins but they keep coming back. Why?

A: Spider veins (Telangiectasias) are often treated with sclerotherapy, a medication injected into the vein so it shrinks away. Sclerotherapy is strictly cosmetic and treats only the visible veins. If spider veins recur in the same place or nearby, this indicates that the problem lies in the main veins, which are unaffected by surface treatments. Before further surface treatment, you should see a vascular physician to be fully assessed for circulatory health. ▣
