Shade garden attracts critters, visitors

PLENTY OF INSPIRATION IN UPCOMING 'GOING NATIVE GARDEN TOUR'

Native flowers aren't the only things sprouting up in the garden this spring. All sorts of creatures have been finding sanctuary in Renate Ka's back yard in Mountain View.

"The hummingbirds are just crazy. When I brush my teeth in the morning I can watch them through the window," Ka said.

Ka's lively garden will be one of the 45 featured sights on this year's Going Native Garden Tour on Sunday, April 29. The tour focuses on the use of California native plants and green-gardening methods in locations throughout the Santa Clara and San Mateo counties. Registration is free, but spots fill up quickly, and about 1,500 people have already signed up for this year's tour.

Three years ago, her yard on Foxborough Drive would have had nothing more than a small pool and a patchy lawn, but today it is a sculpted yard filled with lush, low-growing plants and stone ornaments.

Renate Ka, the homeowner, initiated the transformation soon

after moving in, and saw it as an extension of her already environmentally conscious lifestyle.

"For me, going native is part of being green as far as I'm concerned. You're supporting the animals and the birds and

the lizards and the bees and insects," she said one afternoon as she sat on her patio, looking out over the garden.

The soft slopes of the Japanese bridge and "Mediterranean mounds" carry the eyes easily from one space to the next. At the far end, a kidney-shaped expanse of decomposed granite lies where the pool used to, giving the garden a tranquil atmosphere.

Ka is quick to mention that she had help with the project. She worked with Chris Todd, a landscape designer whose company, Garden Escapes, specializes in native plants.

Even then, Ka says she wasn't "too religious" about having only native plants.

"I kind of didn't want to be too radical and kill everything I had," she said, adding that the garden is as much for her as it is for the local habitat. "I tend to be a more casual gardener — I do everything myself, and I hate leaf blowers."

The area reflects this more passive approach. Ka has allowed the plants to take on their own shape, and nothing seems over-manicured.

Creepers and low bushes abound, exquisite to the last detail. White blossoms hang from the manzanita plants like tiny bells, and the mint-scented salvia leaves are coated in a soft down.

Ka's lot isn't a typical example of California native gardens because a row of tall redwood trees in her neighbor's yard blocks much of the light. "We have the shade natives, and they're a little less flashy."

She has still managed to find plants that thrive on the soil, which she has layered with redwood bark. "I've really tried to have something in the garden I can show all year round," Ka said.

Poppies give the yard bursts of color in spots where the sun manages to get through, and in the shade lavender coral bells have just sprung up. Much of the garden is filled with lush leaves that will be eclipsed by bright flowers once the tour starts.

Here and there the growth is broken by Ka's own decorations: a bird bath near the bridge and a large stone Buddha's face nestled in the corner.

Ka devoted extensive attention to her garden, making sure that it provides more than just aesthetics to the environment. "I don't use pesticides, and I fertilize almost exclusively with compost. I have my own compost, and sometimes I get some from Redwood City."

She cut down significantly on her water usage by installing agricultural drips that provide "moisture cones," and by setting

up four separate irrigation zones.

None of the non-native plants included are invasive. "I once had this Cotoneaster that had just beautiful red berries, but then a friend told me it was invasive, and I got rid of it," Ka said.

Soon after going native, Ka noticed that more and more animals were visiting her garden. She enjoyed them so much that she hired Josiah Clark, consulting ecologist and naturalist, to help her "attract critters."

"I had a lizard early last spring, but then it just disappeared. It was fun, you know? They sit there and do their pushups." She later put in redwood branches to encourage its return. Squirrels and birds also frequent her garden, where "there's more than enough to eat."

Ka is equally inviting to the tour participants. "I'm really looking forward to having people come. It's inspiring to me to think that people go and start to think about planting their own native garden," she said.

The shade will provide a nice break from the direct sunlight most other tour gardens have, and the garden designer will probably be there to answer specific questions.

As Ka sits in the redwoods' shadow, it is clear that the project has given her untold amounts of pleasure.

"For me it's always a relaxing thing, being in the garden. There's always a weed to pull and something to water," she said. She believes the tour allows her to spread her passion for wildlife to visitors, whether or not they plan

to start their own native garden.

Gardening, she said, "is a perfect therapy for the middle-aged woman. I think it's just good for people's bodies and people's souls to spend time outside."

Even now she is investigating new additions to her garden, such as a wine barrel that would host water plants. "You know, it's never finished. Every year something different happens." ▀

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Food for a healthy home

Food has become so confusing. In the good old days, farmers picked their produce when it was ripe and brought it to market locally. Since most fertilizers and pesticides had not yet been invented, they planted diverse crops and rotated them to keep pests down and soil fertility up. Fresh, locally grown, pesticide-free produce was the result.

But times changed. By the middle of the last century, industrialization of farming practices increasingly made local family farming uneconomical, and agribusiness was born. Today most of our food is grown and raised on giant homogeneous farms that ship their products across the country and the globe. Since crop diversity and rotation are expensive on a large scale, today's farms tend to be giant expanses of a single crop. Large homogeneous farms quickly exhaust the soil of nutrients and gather crop-specific pests and diseases.

With each application of pesticides, pests undergo evolutionary changes that make them resistant to pesticides. Industrially grown crops require increasingly intense pesticide and fertilizer applications over time to keep pests in check and compensate for soil exhaustion. Crops today are bred to be better able to resist the assaults of pesticides and shipping. The more robust varieties used today lack the flavor

and nutritional qualities of our grandparents' food. The result is cheap, insipid food often laced with pesticides.

One billion pounds of pesticides are applied in the U.S. every year. Currently, there are over 20,000 pesticides in use. Federally funded research has linked agricultural pesticides to increased rates of cancer, birth defects and Parkinson's disease. According to the EPA, children are especially sensitive to pesticides because their internal organs are still developing. Pesticides may block the absorption of important nutrients necessary for healthy growth in children.

Inhumane conditions

Livestock has undergone a similar "revolution." In the relentless pursuit of increasing production and profit, the animals in our food supply today are pumped full of chemicals and housed in horrifically cruel environments. Most of the chickens we serve to our families are crammed together in cages that allow each bird 67 square inches, about two thirds the size of a piece of paper. The extreme crowding leads to cannibalism, so the birds are de-beaked. To a chicken, the beak is both its hands and its mouth. They are given large amounts of antibiotics because the overcrowded conditions breed diseases. Cows and pigs are treated equally poorly.

An important measure of a civilization is

how well it treats its powerless. It is extremely uncomfortable to think about how we treat our animals. In our pursuit of efficiency we have lost sight of our humanity. The antibiotics and growth hormones we feed our livestock is also showing up in milk and in our river systems, increasing antibiotic resistance of bacteria and damaging wildlife.

Seafood is also in a dire situation. Commercial fisheries are collapsing, and a third of the fish species humans eat have already been exhausted from over-fishing. According to recent research, if we continue current trends, in just 30 years all the remaining fisheries will have collapsed, perhaps permanently.

Community farming

What we eat affects the health of our families and the health of our planet. So how do you navigate the confusing minefield of the modern food industry?

There is hope, and it is much easier than you think. By and large, the same decisions that improve your family's health are also good for the planet.

Groceries account for a mere 1.5 percent of our income, and much of that is on relatively expensive and unwholesome processed foods. Food is extremely cheap by historical standards. Even if we paid twice as much for fruits and vegetables to improve the quality of our food supply, it would still account for a negligible amount of our household budget.

"Community service agriculture" is a great way to preserve local small farms and be able to support healthy and humanely raised foods. CSAs are local farms or small farm cooperatives that provide fresh food locally, often at

locations convenient to city dwellers. They are usually organic family farms, and also tend to treat their livestock more humanely. Hidden Villa in Los Altos Hills is an organic CSA (and a fun and educational place to visit with the kids). Others can be found at Local Harvest's Web site, www.localharvest.org.

Farmers markets are also good sources for locally grown foods. As farmers markets have grown in popularity, however, an increasing number of vendors are buying food at produce wholesalers and passing it off as local and organic. When buying produce, ask the vendor if they are growing the food locally themselves and where their farm is located.

When buying food from non-organic sources, their toxicity and "washability" (many pesticides cannot be washed off with water) vary considerably. Non-organic apples, peaches and bell peppers have some of the worst pesticides. Visit www.organicpicks.com for a list of pesticides and produce, as well as info on Bay Area farmers markets and CSAs.

Finally, purchasing eggs and poultry from free-range chickens, and milk and beef from cows that are grass-fed and free of antibiotics and hormones, supports sustainable farming practices. And the Marine Stewardship Council's Web site, <http://eng.msc.org>, has a great database of sustainable seafood fisheries and suppliers.

Serving healthy, tasty and responsibly grown food is easier today than it has been for decades, if you know where to look. ■
