The roads both taken

ITINERANT PAINTER PURSUES ABSTRACT AND FIGURATIVE PATHS, WITH A EUROPEAN FLAIR

Silver-tipped tubes of oil paint cluster like a school of fish. This is just the beginning.

"You start with 20 or 30 colors and you can mix 2,000," artist Mitchell Johnson says. And his palette blossoms the more he travels. Into the mix he adds frenetic yellows and reds inspired by winter coats he saw in Beijing, the honeyed greens of a Tuscan field at sunset, the sky in Denmark.

As a child, Johnson was mesmerized by the blue of the letters on a board game called "Tugboat." Now his work is driven by color, and he finds new hues wherever he goes.

In other countries, for example, people often paint their houses or vehicles with colors that would be unusual in America. Instead of staring at the Eiffel Tower, he points out cars. "I'm always driving my wife crazy when we travel," he says.

Tones of color and light sometimes creep subtly into his paintings. In his airy, 1,000-square-foot space at Cubberley Studios in Palo Alto, Johnson points to one scene painted in France. It does look like the French countryside, but you'd be hard-pressed to say why.

"How much do you have to put in there before someone thinks it's France?" Johnson asks rhetorically. "Do you add a characteristic tree?"

But the painting's Continental feel is gentler than this: something about the angle of the morning sunlight, perhaps, or the glow of the pasture.

Johnson, who lives in Menlo Park with his wife and young son, spends time living and painting in Europe every year, most often gravitating to the Tuscan town of Buonconvento and the French village of Meyreuil, near Aix-en-Provence.

In Italy, Johnson made a fortuitous connection: He got to know Marilena Pasquali, who ran a museum in Bologna devoted

to the Italian painter Giorgio Morandi. Out of their conversations grew the new book "Doppio Binario," which includes a Pasquali essay on Johnson's work along with numerous color plates of his art.

The book is now on sale at the Cantor Art Center bookshop at Stanford University and at Kepler's bookstore in Menlo Park. Next door to Kepler's at Cafe Borrone there's a new exhibit of Johnson's paintings, running through June 10.

A miniature retrospective of Johnson's paintings is also on exhibit at Los Altos Hills Town Hall through June 6.

The book's title ("double track" in Italian) refers to the two paths that Johnson takes with his paintings: abstract and figurative. A full-time artist, Johnson has become known for his landscapes of Europe and California, which include sprawling houses, window frames and barns; he

Pear's 'Playboy' fails to plumb depths of classic dark comedy

When John Millington Synge's comedy, "The Playboy of the Western World," premiered in 1907, it sparked a week of riots at Dublin's Abbey Theatre. Critics charged that Synge had "plumbed new depths of vulgarity" and that the play, set in County Mayo on Ireland's northwest coast, slandered the character of that region's simple folk.

A hundred years later and 7,000 miles away, it may be difficult for audiences encountering the play at Pear Avenue Theatre in Mountain View to understand what all the fuss was

about. Maybe this is because social mores have changed: "The Playboy of the Western World" seems tame now when compared to even the most innocuous episode of "The Simpsons." Maybe it's because local audiences are so far removed in time and place from the heated debates on Irish national identity that surrounded the play's original production.

Maybe too, though, it is evidence of a fundamental shortcoming in the Pear's staging of Synge's masterpiece. If we are unable to fathom the serious

passions aroused in the Dublin audience, perhaps it is because director William Kenney and his cast in the Pear production have not taken the show seriously enough themselves.

"Playboy" is a comedy, certainly, and the Pear's opening night audience greeted it with appreciative laughter. But it is a dark comedy at best, tinged with a tragic air.

The plot — reputedly based on a true story related to Synge during one of his visits to Ireland's impoverished Aran Islands — concerns a young man on the run from the law. Christopher Mahon (known as "Christy"), appears one night at a rural tavern, starving and filthy from

11 nights of sleeping in ditches. After a bit of questioning, Christy reveals his crime: He killed his father, he says, by splitting the old man's skull with a spade.

The play's comedy stems from the villagers' reaction. Rather than turn Christy over to the hated English authorities, they make of him a sort of folk hero. The tavern owner gives him a job and a bed by the

fireside. The town's young women bring him cake and ducks' eggs and a boiled chicken. Soon the taverner's daughter, Pegeen Mike, is sparring with the Widow Quin for the boy's affections.

The cast play the humor well and handle Synge's poetic language with apparent ease. Thom Gorrebeek is immediately likeable as Christy, a look of wonder never far from his face as he blossoms under the unexpected attention, surprising himself with his own charm and confidence. "Wasn't I a foolish fellow," he muses at the close of the first scene, "not to kill my father in the years gone by." Shannon Stowe and Nicole Lungerhausen also turn in strong performances as Pegeen and the Widow Quin, respectively. Stowe seems to inhabit her character organically, and Lungerhausen wisely underplays the widow's scheming, trusting the audience members to suss out her motives for themselves.

But no one in the cast (with the possible exception of Stowe) seems willing to venture into the darker corners of the story. We never see the underlying desperation that leads a poor and politically oppressed people to make a hero of a man who murders his tyrannical father in a moment of passion. As a result, the central premise of the story becomes a mere "What if?" scenario — funny, yes, but not particularly real. And since nothing particularly

chooses scenes “full of geometry and activity.” But he also pursues abstract painting.

Recently, his abstract oils have moved away from his earlier organic, soft-edged approach. Current works feature patterns of rectangles and squares painted with a deliberate hand — sometimes with the help of a tape measure.

While some people can find abstract work less accessible, Pasquali finds Johnson’s abstract paintings a natural complement to the figurative, especially when they’re exhibited next to landscapes and viewers can see the similarities, she wrote in “Doppio Binario.”

“Skies, water, fields, trees and houses have become surfaces, physical areas of paint distilled from ripe yellow wheat, fertile red earth and boundless blue space — all of this to affirm that the abstractions and landscapes are kin,” she wrote.

Johnson earned a master’s of fine arts from the graduate painting program at Parsons School of Design in New York City in 1990, and has been exhibiting in the States and Europe since 1989.

In his studio, where abstracts and landscapes mingle on the walls, Johnson demurs when

asked about his creative process. He says he paints simply by instinct, blending or juxtaposing colors until they feel right.

“I’m always looking at how colors play against each other, and

some sections draw the eye more than others,” he says, gesturing to a grouping of small abstract paintings. “It’s like music: Everything’s working together, but something’s playing the lead.”

“Water Towers” trips between abstract and figurative. The 2005 painting shows a pair of water towers, but there’s something dreamlike, too. The red-and-white-striped towers stand tall against a secretive black background. Both have light-green stripes at the bottom, and a visitor taking photographs in the studio says he likes the green because it gives his eyes a place to rest.

Johnson often includes a block of solid color on the side of a figurative painting. This can add contrast, emphasizing other colors. For instance, the vertical band of blue-purple on the side of “Cadiere D’Azur” makes the salmon tones in a house roof leap out.

That’s part of the enjoyment of color: pairing up tones and seeing how one affects the other, Johnson says. He often uses “slippery” colors, pale hues that shift easily.

“Put pale green next to yellow, and it becomes strong green. Put it next to strong green, and it becomes yellow,” he says. “The qualities of color are like people, more or less affected by what’s around them.” ■

real is at stake, we have little reason to care what happens to these characters.

The problem is exacerbated shortly before intermission, when Christy’s new-found status is threatened by the arrival of his father — quite alive despite the horrid gash in his head. Because the play has unfolded with a sitcom-like casualness, the audience is not prepared for the very real violence that follows in the final scene, and — as a result — that violence is neither compelling nor believable.

Adding to the problem is the difficulty of staging a convincing fight in such a small space and in such close proximity to the audience. Since no fight choreographer is credited in the program, the lackluster combat can presumably be laid squarely on director Kenney’s shoulders.

Synge himself wrote of the play: “Although parts of it are, or are meant to be, extravagant comedy, still a great deal that is in it, and a great deal more that is behind it, is perfectly serious.” While the Pear’s production undeniably succeeds in capturing the comedy, it gives short shrift to the serious elements. This toothless “Playboy” is enjoyable while it lasts, but unlikely to leave a lasting impression. ■
