Good moves for a better back

'ANTHROPOLOGICAL' APPROACH FOCUSES ON ELIMINATING PAIN THROUGH POSTURE, MOVEMENT

Ben Davidson, assistant dean of students at Stanford University, has always led an active lifestyle: dancing, running, swimming or hiking on a daily basis. But after straining his lower back in 1989, he began to gradually experience a decrease in mobility due to chronic back pain.

Davidson had tried more than 15 different types of treatment, both alternative and traditional, including physical therapy, sports medicine, acupuncture, shiatsu and applied kinesiology, with no success. He also contemplated back surgery.

Then, he met Esther Gokhale and learned her method of using healthy posture to relieve pain.

"Before beginning treatment with Esther, I hadn't experienced a day or night without pain in over a decade," he said.

He never thought the method would be effective so quickly.

"After working with Esther, I saw a remarkable improvement almost immediately. It changed my life. It gave me back my ability to be physically active and live without pain. I have an immense amount of gratitude to her," he said.

Gokhale said she believes the root of chronic back pain, as well as neck, hip, and knee pain, is bad posture.

"Most back pain is addressable, in my experience. The only exception is irreversible genetic abnormalities, which are rare," she said.

Gokhale teaches people how to reestablish their natural posture and maintain it through movement. She borrows ideas from other disciplines, including the Alexander technique, Feldenkrais method,

Pilates, yoga and dance, among others. Ultimately, the Gokhale method is a way for people to return to the posture they had when they were babies — what is in their genes, she said.

Gokhale focuses on lengthening and straightening muscles as opposed to shortening and straightening them. Patients focus on simple changes, including sitting with the tail bone out, as opposed to tucking the pelvis in.

Halle Agdassi, a physician at the Palo Alto Medical Foundation who specializes in physical medicine and rehabilitation, has been referring patients to Gokhale for several years.

How to live well in a toxic world

PHYSICAL MALADIES OFTEN ARE CAUSED BY BODY'S RESPONSE TO POLLUTANTS

A few decades ago we didn't have all the autoimmune diseases and allergies that people are experiencing today. Just in the last 15 years many more people developed allergies to foods that once were not a problem, such as wheat.

We live in a very toxic world — foods are altered with synthetic hormones, antibiotics, radiated and genetically engineered. Heavy metals from amalgams and pesticides and many different chemical compounds pollute the air, soil and water. Also, we use more prescription and/or recreational drugs, alcohol and over-the-counter medications than ever before.

These substances pollute the bloodstream, the liver and other excreting organs like kidneys, liver, lungs, large intestine and skin. When these excreting organs are bombarded daily by these substances, an accumulation occurs, and the organs can no longer perform their jobs efficiently. At this point, auto-intoxication takes place.

Inflammation is one of the first signs of impaired organ function. Inflammation is a warning sign that something is not working right, something inside our body is stuck and is not being processed or eliminated correctly. Often it is a substance that our organs or systems cannot process because it is unrecognizable by them.

Taking anti-inflammatory drugs will not correct such a problem; it will just suppress the symptoms, and later the internal imbalance will show up again, maybe somewhere else, and can worsen.

Toxicity and inflammation create free radicals that damage

your cells and can predispose your body to various diseases like chronic fatigue, IBS, Crohns, and more serious ones like arthritis, multiple sclerosis, lupus and cancer. Also, there is a connection between toxicity and weight and skin problems, because when the body's excreting organs do not work properly an accumulation of waste and fat takes place. This manifests in acne, psoriasis, eczema and obesity.

How do we keep our body functioning correctly? The first thing is to eliminate or reduce the exposure to unnecessary sources of chemicals, and to use environmentally safe products to clean your house. Buying organic foods is also recommended.

Keep the use of over-the-counter medications to a minimum. If you experience migraines, there may be a straightforward physical cause for it. You might have allergies to some foods you are not aware of, or your liver is congested from too many toxins, or there is a deficiency, or a combination of all of these problems.

A competent health practitioner can help you to detoxify your body by finding what organs are having trouble and balancing them using natural remedies. The over-the-counter medications usually don't resolve these issues, they are just a Band-Aid, and your pain will return.

Ask your health care practitioner what kinds of tests are available to detect which organs are not functioning optimally, and the types of natural approaches they offer to help re-establish a healthy internal function. ■

Heartburn: Routine ailment or red flag?

Q: What causes heartburn and/or GERD?

A: Many of us know heartburn as that burning sensation in the chest, usually due to overeating. It may also be accompanied by a feeling of fluid flowing back into your throat and a sour taste in your mouth. Forty percent of adults in the U.S. have occasional symptoms of heartburn, and 10 percent experience these symptoms regularly.

These symptoms occur when the muscle at the end of the esophagus relaxes, allowing acid and digestive enzymes from the stomach to flow into the esophagus. This is known as gastroesophageal reflux disease, or GERD. It can cause injury to the esophagus called esophagitis, or it can cause symptoms in the absence of esophageal injury.

Q: Isn't GERD just heartburn with a longer medical name?

A: Yes and no. Although these terms are sometimes used synonymously, people are more typically said to have GERD if their reflux symptoms are frequent or severe, or if complications of reflux are identified.

Q: Can GERD lead to complications?

A: One risk is the development of an ulcer in the esophagus that can cause pain or bleeding. Another less common complication is scar tissue, called a stricture, which blocks the movement of swallowed food through the esophagus. Esophageal reflux may also cause certain less common symptoms, such as hoarseness or chronic cough, and sometimes provokes conditions such as asthma.

In a minority of cases, GERD can lead to a precancerous condition called Barrett's esophagus. In this case, an abnormal lining of the esophagus develops which has the potential to give rise to esophageal cancer. In patients with longstanding, frequent heartburn, an endoscopy to evaluate for the presence of this condition can be considered.

It is important to note that

most people with heartburn will never develop any of these complications.

Q: What can I do to reduce my heartburn and avoid GERD?

A: I advise my patients with frequent acid reflux problems to make diet and lifestyle changes combined with, or followed by, a short course of prescription medication.

Start with these simple (though not always easy) changes:

- Try taking an over-the-counter antacid as needed
- Stay away from acidic foods, like tomato sauce and citrus fruits and juices
- Eat less fatty food
- Indulge minimally in sweets, particularly chocolate
- Eat smaller, more frequent meals
- Don't eat within two to three hours of bedtime
- Get to and maintain a healthy weight
- Avoid alcohol and tobacco

If, after another two to four weeks of making these efforts, there is no improvement, you should see your physician regarding treatment. Consultation with a gastroenterologist should be considered if your symptoms are particularly severe or longstanding, or if evidence of a complication develops.

Q: Is it harmful to take antacids for a long time?

A: When taken according to the manufacturer's instructions, there are very rarely complications from taking over-the-counter antacids. Taking excessive amounts of antacids for an extended time can, however, be quite dangerous.

People diagnosed with GERD are sometimes prescribed more powerful medications called proton pump inhibitors (PPIs). Their doctor will watch them for side effects from this medication, which can hinder calcium absorption.

Q: Do you recommend any vitamins or supplements for GERD sufferers?

A: Not typically, but for patients taking PPIs, it's helpful to supplement your diet with calcium and vitamin D. ■

“It is a tool that people can use on an everyday basis to sit, stand and carry themselves. It’s an easy method to use in daily life. All my patients who have had lower back pain and used her method have had success,” she said.

Gokhale’s anthropological and anatomical approaches set her method apart, according to Agdassi.

Traveling in Africa, Europe, Asia and South America, Gokhale stud-

ied traditional cultures that have low incidences of muscle and joint problems, and incorporated her observations into her technique. Clients emulate photographs of people with correct postures from around the world.

“The less industrial a country, the more likely you are to find people with correct posture and movement. In Chad, 5 percent of people suffer from back pain sometime in their lives; in the United States that number is 80 percent. My mission in life is to close that gap,” Gokhale said.

She also uses medical litera-

ture and anatomical arguments to back her ideas. Western and Eastern approaches reflect both her interest in alternative medicine and her scientific background. After graduating from Princeton University with a degree in biochemistry, Gokhale studied acupuncture at San Francisco College of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine.

But her lifelong dedication to understanding and addressing the root of back pain began when she had back problems of her own. When pregnant with her first child, Gokhale suffered from sciatica, with pain beginning in the hip and continuing down the leg. She underwent back surgery, but for years thereafter she continued to have recurring back pain.

She studied in Paris with yoga teacher Noelle Perez in Aplomb, a French movement-re-education technique that focused on posture; then she traveled and studied cultures where there is low incidence of back pain.

“I teach people to return to the normal shape of their spine and preserve it in their movement. Almost every person who takes my class grows one-quarter to one-half an inch from straightening out their spine,” she said.

To achieve maximum success, her method must be taught using three components: the kinesthetic, visual and intellectual, she said.

“These three channels allow people to not only feel the difference in posture, but to see the differences in images and understand the anatomy behind it,” she said.

Images are vital in learning correct posture, she said. “We’re little monkeys, we copy each other.”

People are also intellectually driven, and knowing the reasoning behind what someone is doing motivates people to work harder, she said.

“I think her method is very sound anatomically, kinesthetically and clinically. I like that she uses an anthropological basis for her work and incorporates yoga and dance,” client Davidson said.

Agdassi believes in Gokhale’s method so strongly that she is spearheading a medical study to evaluate its benefits. Meanwhile, Gokhale has written a book, “Eight Steps to a Pain Free Back,” that she hopes will be in stores by spring 2008. It explains her method step by step, with the aid of more than 1,000 images.

She currently hopes to teach children to develop proper posture at an early age. “Early in life is when the neural pathways in the brain are set for sitting and other important positions,” she said. “I want people to develop healthy habits as soon as possible.” ■

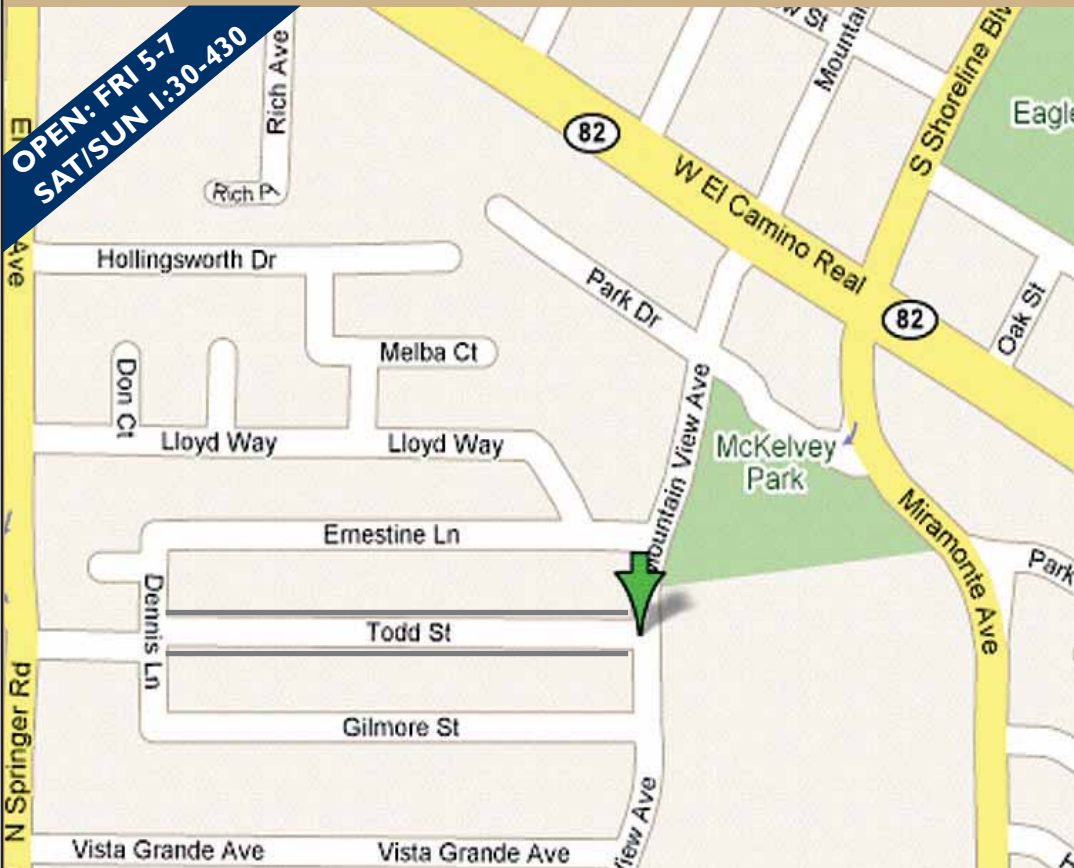

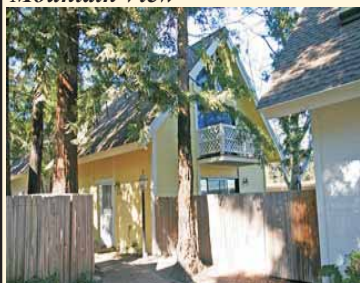

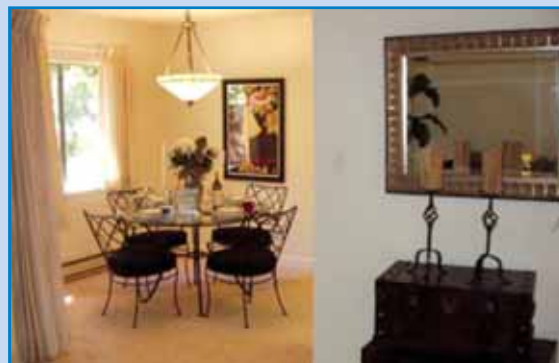
