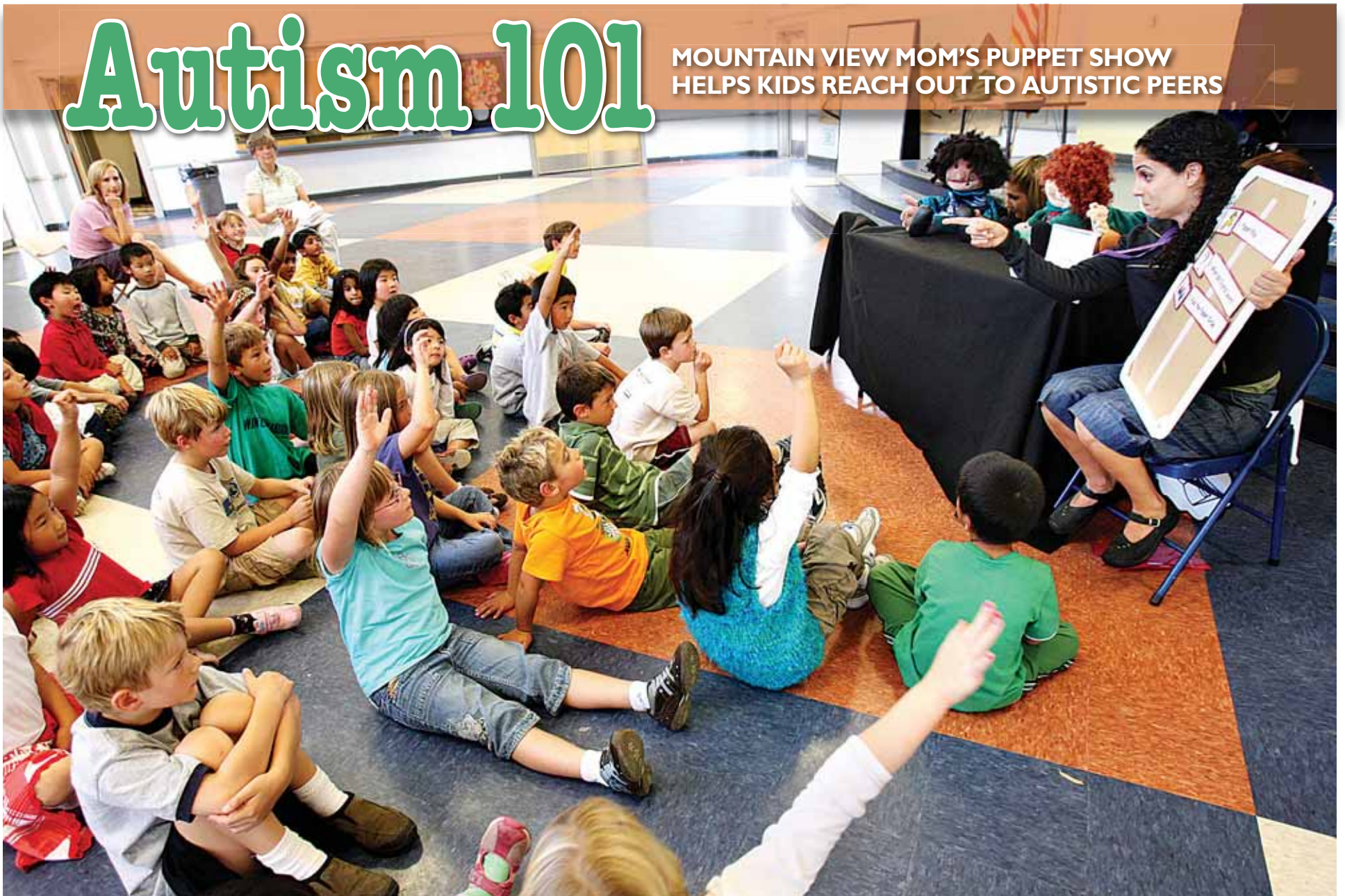

MOUNTAIN VIEW MOM'S PUPPET SHOW HELPS KIDS REACH OUT TO AUTISTIC PEERS

One recent morning at Covington Elementary School in Los Altos, dozens of children gathered to watch the story of how three puppets named Freddie, Crystal and Angela became friends.

Freddie sat hidden behind his laptop busily working away. Crystal, energetic and gregarious, danced for the crowd, while a teacher puppet — a goose named Mrs. Beaks — and a classroom aide called Monkey Bones facilitated the friendship.

“Last year Freddie and I didn’t play together very much,” Crystal said to the students. “Freddie is not like other kids, he’s different.” “I have the kind of mind that has autism,” Freddie said.

“I bet you really want friends,” Mrs. Beaks said to Freddie.

“I do,” Freddie said.

The puppet show is part of an effort by volunteer coordinator Fran Goodwin, a Mountain View resident and mother of an 11-year-old autistic boy, to help elementary school-aged children learn to make friends with someone who is autistic.

Goodwin says she isn’t trying to promote awareness of autism, exactly; instead she’s

focused on interaction. Just as people have learned to make friends with the blind and the deaf, children can learn to make friends with autistic children, she said.

“Regular kids can get a lot of enjoyment making friends with other children who are autistic,” Goodwin said. But autistic children, though often talented in the arts, music and math, have difficulty with communication. In a social situation autistic children will often stand outside the circle or keep to themselves.

As a result, they do not actively seek out friends, Goodwin said. The puppet shows give gregarious children the tools they need to get autistic kids to open up.

“It takes a kind of confident kid” to make friends with someone who has autism, she said. “But at the same time they have to have a special quality of being able to put themselves in someone else’s shoes. If you want to play with a child that’s autistic, you kind of have to think about, ‘Are they enjoying this as much as I am?’ You might find someone who’s got amazing gifts.”

Building a friendship with someone who has autism takes patience, as the puppet show reveals. When Crystal first asks Freddie if he

wants to play a game together, he rebuffs her with an abrupt "No." Not knowing what to do, Crystal turns to Mrs. Beaks, who advises her to use Freddie's name and to speak slowly.

Crystal goes through a series of steps, such as using Freddie's name when she asks him questions. She speaks slowly and watches what Freddie does. But Freddie never looks up from his laptop. When Crystal asks Freddie what he's doing, he makes strange noises like "Echa, echa, echa" — a kind of self-regulating behavior called a stym.

Ultimately, Freddie reveals to Crystal that he has drawn an ani-

mated picture of a popular television cartoon character. Crystal asks Freddie if he can show her how to draw. He agrees, and the two become friends.

The Wings Learning Center, a school for autistic children based in Burlingame, adopted Goodwin's roving show earlier this year as part of a community outreach program. The show was created by Heather McCracken of the Friend 2 Friend Social Learning Society, a Canadian nonprofit.

Everyone has a stym, the volunteers explained to the children after the show. Then the volunteers, all speech therapists and teachers at Wings Learning Center, asked children what they do to calm themselves when they get nervous. The answers included "bite my fingernails," "pick my nose" and "suck my thumb."

Just as everyone has nervous habits, and is good at some things but not as good at other things, so Freddie has a habit of making sounds, and has strengths and weaknesses, the volunteers said.

"Just as we're all different, we have to accept our differences," Goodwin said. ■

No saying 'nuts' to food allergies

Q: Why does everyone seem to have a food allergy these days?

A: Though the reasons are poorly understood, the prevalence of food allergies does appear to be on the rise. The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) estimates that food allergies affect between 4 to 8 percent of children and 2 percent of adults.

A food allergy develops when a person's immune system produces IgE antibodies directed against a specific food. When that food is eaten, the IgE antibodies recognize the food and trigger the release of massive amounts of chemicals, including histamine, which then cause a wide range of symptoms throughout the body. The symptoms usually begin within minutes of eating the food and typically include itching, rashes, hives and/or swelling of the lips or eyelids. More severe reactions can include swelling of the tongue or throat, breathing difficulty, vomiting or a drop in blood pressure. In rare cases, these symptoms can be life threatening.

Ninety percent of food allergies are caused by eight foods: milk, eggs, peanuts, tree nuts, soy, wheat, fish and shellfish. It is possible, however, for any food to cause an allergic reaction.

Q: My child's school has a "No Nuts" lunch table and strict rules about what snacks and treats we can bring to class parties. Isn't this overkill?

A: These types of policies can seem excessive, but you need to realize that children with nut allergies can have life-threatening reactions if they are exposed to even tiny amounts of nuts. We call these severe reactions anaphylaxis. Symptoms often develop within just a few minutes of exposure to the food, and can include breathing trouble, swelling of the throat and low blood pressure. Left untreated, anaphylactic shock can lead to death in a matter of minutes.

While most people with food allergies are not at risk of anaphylaxis, nuts are the most common food cause of anaphylactic reactions in children. Most people successfully avoid experiencing anaphylactic shock by avoiding their allergens — hence the importance of the "No Nuts" table at school.

Q: Can you outgrow a food allergy or sensitivity?

A: There is no "cure" for food allergies, but you may outgrow them. Sometimes children outgrow food allergies, often before the age of 5. Unfortunately, people allergic to peanuts, tree nuts, fish and shellfish rarely outgrow their allergy. Some people believe that food allergy reactions get worse every time you eat the food, but the reactions actually tend to be similar with repeat exposures. It is always possible, however, that subsequent reactions might be more severe, so it's best to prepare for the worst.

If you are unsure about your sensitivity to a food, keep a food diary for a couple of weeks. List everything you eat, what symptoms you experience, and when they occur. Share this information with your doctor, who can combine your findings with an exam and tests, and help determine what food is causing negative reactions.

Q: If I have an allergy, will my children get it too?

A: The tendency to develop allergies is genetically determined, but the specific allergies are not inherited. For example, a child whose parents are both allergic to cats has a good chance of developing allergies himself, but will not necessarily develop an allergy to cats.

It's the same with food allergies. We believe that breastfeeding for at least one year is best to guard the baby from allergy vulnerability. When there is a strong family history of allergies, we often recommend delaying the introduction of egg whites until the child is 18 months of age, and delaying the introduction of peanuts, tree nuts, fish and shellfish until the child is 3 years old. This may decrease the chances that the child will develop food allergies.

Exotic, but limited

WES ANDERSON'S 'THE DARJEELING LIMITED' MAKES SMALL TRIBUTES TO BOLLYWOOD

For a non-Bollywood film set in India, see maverick director Wes Anderson's "The Darjeeling Limited," a goofy family saga taking place on a train as it rolls through the Indian countryside.

The movie stars Owen Wilson, Adrian Brody and Jason Schwartzman as Francis, Peter and Jack, three estranged brothers seeking spiritual enlightenment and to repair their broken bonds. All three seem to be running from something and carrying, literally and emotionally, a lot of baggage: Francis is recovering from a near-death experience; Peter's other half is pregnant with their first child; and Jack is trying to cope with a failed relationship.

All the while, their train, the Darjeeling Limited, speeds through the desert region of Rajasthan, moving from the city of Jodhpur all the way to Jaisalmer. As it turns out, the train route is fictional: The actual city of



Darjeeling lies in the east of India nestled in the Himalayas, something we never see in this film.

Although Anderson had never been to India before, he says he had long been in love with its landscape, and was especially inspired by Jean Renoir's "The River," a coming-of-age story set in Bengal, as well as the sweeping emotional films of master Indian filmmaker Satyajit Ray. As a tribute to Ray, Anderson borrowed original music from several of his films.

There's not much of a role for the only Bollywood actor in the movie, Irfan Khan, who (despite being prominent in India) has a mere cameo in this film, with no more than four lines. On the other hand, newcomer Amara Karan, who plays Rita or "The Sweet Lime Girl," has a good supporting role.

What Rita encounters surprises even a sweet lime girl: Three

American brothers on a strange trek through India, planned from the start by Francis, the Owen Wilson character, as he tries to put together a family reunion. Francis works hard to include their mother Patricia (Angelica Houston), who is also adept at running away, having abandoned her family to join a remote convent of nuns. As in previous films, Anderson creates quirky, odd personalities and manages to examine their dysfunctional lives with humor and whimsy.

The production value is superb as Anderson takes us to several amazing locales. The color palette and art design are exquisite, and the 11 pieces of luggage, which are so ubiquitous that they begin to feel like part of the cast, are designed by none other than Marc Jacobs for Louis Vuitton.

Anderson's films are not for everyone, and require a certain eclectic taste. Unlike some of his other films, "The Darjeeling Limited" — though interesting, visually captivating and easy to admire — never fully engages the viewer on an emotional level. ▣

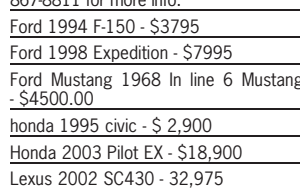

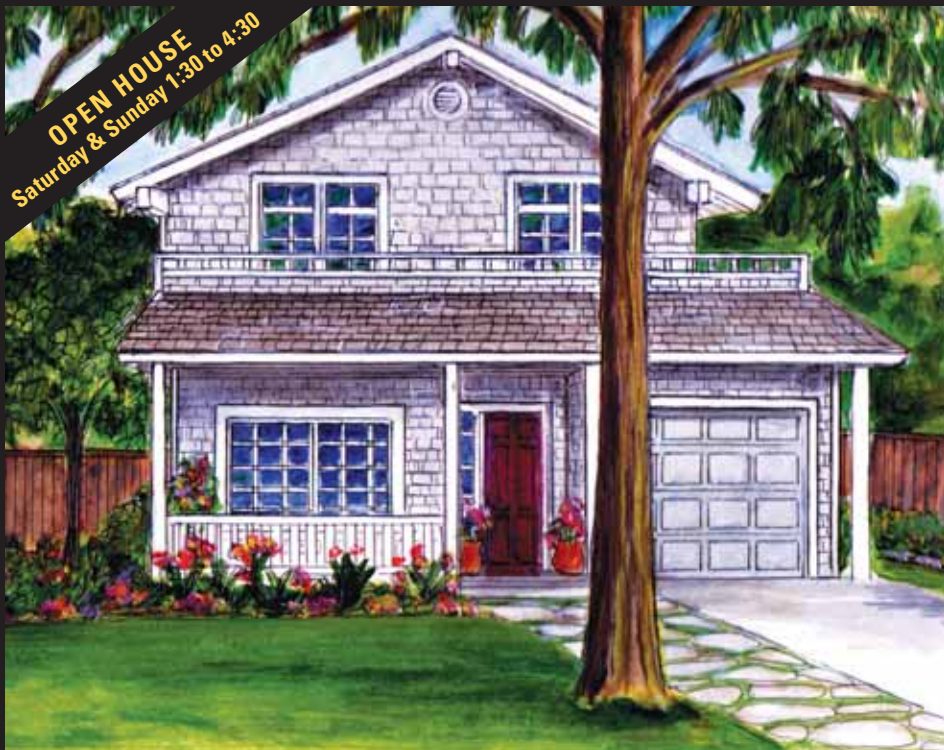
