



What a difference A HALF-CENTURY MAKES

In the 1940s and '50s, teens flocked to Johnny Mac's; today the iconic building stands vacant and available

Long before McDonald's started selling its Big Mac all around the world, the original Big Mac burger was served at a Mountain View drive-in called Johnny Mac's.

That's how Vivian Shatz remembers it, and she was a carhop there for seven years in the late 1940s and early '50s. The burger wasn't the main thing luring teens to Johnny Mac's, she said — it was simply the place to be. Cars would fill the parking lot and spill out onto El Camino Real as carhops busily took orders and brought out trays of food.

"It was the place to go, the place to take your girlfriends," Shatz said. It was especially popular after teens left the drive-in movie theater on Grant Road, behind the current Walgreens on El Camino.

Today, the Johnny Mac's building stands empty on El Camino near Mountain View Avenue, an aging link to the past. A dry cleaner called Camaro Cleaners was the last tenant, but the

space has been left empty over the last year. Building owner Kirk Richards, who also owns the Napa Auto Parts next door, says he gets regular calls from prospective tenants, like the guy who wanted to turn it into a hot dog stand. Richards said he had no idea of its history before the *Voice* called about it.

Another old timer, Eugene Sharp, says Johnny Mac's was one of three places to go as a teen in late 1940s Mountain View, with the others being the movie theater and the "Eagles Shack" dances Saturday nights at the Adobe Building.

The restaurant took its name from Johnny MacLane, one of its three owners. In homage to his Scottish heritage, the carhops' uniforms were dark green with sections of green plaid and gold trim, Shatz said. The cover of the menu has a picture of a cartoonish Johnny Mac figure in Scottish garb. The menu features burgers and shakes for 25 cents.

"It was just a fun time to be around in Mountain View," Shatz said. "The police would

come in and you could give them a free cup of coffee. You can't do that now, it would be bribery." (Shatz was married to Robert K. Shatz, a former police chief and mayor who died in 1997. The police and fire building on Villa Street is named after him.)

MacLane's business partners were his brother in law, Bill Clark, and Clark's best friend

from World War II, Frank "Hop-pie" Hopkins, who handled the accounting side, Shatz said. The trio had opened a Johnny Mac's shortly beforehand in Redwood City and went on to open the Burger Barn restaurants in San Jose, one of which still stands on Forest Avenue. MacLane died of

SmugMug smiles for the camera

Chris MacAskill spent childhood life on Oakland's streets and

could easily have become a homeless statistic. Instead, he gained a master's degree in geophysics from Stanford, learned from Apple CEO Steve Jobs at NeXT and sold his company, Fat-brain, to Barnes and Noble.

When his programmer son Don wanted to start a business, Chris leapt at the chance. Together they founded a photo-sharing site, SmugMug (www.smugmug.com), and created jobs for family members. Today, 25 employees take the responsibility of caring for 230 million photos and 350,000 paying customers very seriously, while generating creative fun.

"It's wonderful to be in a business where you do what you love and help customers develop their creativity," says company president Chris. He enjoys being surprised by the photos his customers present him with each day.

At SmugMug's fifth birthday party, pictures of guests were sent instantly from digital cameras to large computer screens using a service provided by Eye-Fi (www.eye.fi), also from Mountain View. Eye-Fi makes an SD-format wireless memory card that works in most cameras. It transmits pictures from a camera to a computer, Web site, popular photo-sharing site or photo printing store. It also supports Apple's iPhoto application. Shasta Ventures and Opus Capital fund Eye-Fi.

SmugMug is self-funded and profitable, with no venture investors. Users pay from \$40 to \$150 annually. Nonprofits can apply for a free account and there is a

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a heart attack after that, but the others went on to start the Burger

Pit chain as well.

Mountain View's Johnny Mac's would become "Big Mac's" in the 1960s, said Mike Carroll, an artist whose stepfather owned it then. Carroll's rendering of what

Johnny Mac's once looked like is on display in the Mountain View library.

"It was very much a part of the car culture," Carroll said about Johnny Mac's.

Later there was also Linda's drive-in at Rengstorff and El Camino Real, known to this day for its special hamburger sauce, but there was never anything like Johnny Mac's again in Mountain View, Shatz said.

The former drive-in is available

for rent, but the rear portion is used by Ugly's bar and a liquor store. The liquor store owner seemed excited about the idea of a reinvented drive in, as did an employee at Napa Auto Parts.

"We need some good food around here," she said. ■

The site encourages people to join communities of like-minded photographers and participate in its Digital Grin forum.

You can see which photos are the most popular using SmugMug's analytical stats. It is really easy to create personalized gifts from your photos.

SmugMug is not just online — it meets customers in person. It has teamed up with a veteran Atherton photographer, Marc Silber, to

give a series of free photography workshops at its offices. Silber will tell you the secrets of great photographers like Ansel Adams, who meticulously recorded landscapes, and Henri Cartier-Bresson, who impulsively captured the moment. (The next class is Feb. 13.)

As company financing gets tighter and layoffs increase, I hope Voice readers will dream up more businesses like SmugMug, which provides customers with really enjoyable experiences and gives family members the opportunity for fulfilling employment. ■

Muscles of iron, heart of gold

In January of 2005, Mountain View resident Christina Davis had the same New Year's resolutions many of us have — lose weight, get in shape, meet new people, and, now that she was an “adult” with a “real job,” give money to charity.

Coincidentally, a flyer from the Leukemia and Lymphoma Society's Team in Training arrived in the mail that month, and Christina realized that she had found a way to reach all of these goals simultaneously.

Team in Training (TNT) is the world's largest endurance sports training program. It trains ordinary people to succeed in demanding physical events while raising funds for leukemia, lymphoma and myeloma research and patient services. Since 1988, TNT has helped 360,000 participants raise more than \$850 million.

Christina's first event with TNT was an endurance hike in the Grand Canyon in the spring of 2005, a relatively low-

asking friends, family and co-workers to contribute. However, when she participated in her second event later that year, she was reluctant to ask the same people for donations again so soon, so she had to start getting creative with fundraising.

All TNT participants are in a mentor group of four to seven people, and these teams often do group fundraising events. Christina has participated in several such events, which often require months of planning. The most successful fundraiser she helped organize was a bachelor/bachelorette auction for her triathlon last spring.

That event featured TNT “celebrities” (mostly coaches and team managers), who were auctioned off at prices ranging from \$100 to \$750. Combined with proceeds from a raffle and the admission fees, the event raised \$8,200. In true TNT spirit, the organizers then allocated the funds to recognize the efforts of all those involved: event organizers, bachelors and bachelorettes who were TNT members, and

key event that involved “only” 8 hours of hiking to the bottom of the Grand Canyon and back up. Addicted to the physical challenges, camaraderie, and satisfaction of raising money for a great cause, Christina then completed three half-marathons, a marathon and a triathlon over the next 2.5 years.

She is now training for one of the most grueling endurance events in the world: the Ironman. This triathlon features a 2.4 mile open-water swim followed by a 112 mile bike ride and a 26.2 mile marathon. The rigorous TNT training for the event lasts 10 months and ramps up from 15 hours per week of training to 25 hours per week.

In addition to these practices, Christina spends a couple hours per week fundraising. All TNT participants have a fundraising minimum: 25 percent of it covers the cost of training, transportation, lodging, etc. for the participant, and the other 75 percent goes to leukemia and lymphoma research. Christina's minimum for the Ironman is \$8,000.

For Christina's first event, she was able to meet and exceed her fundraising goal simply by

certain cancer survivors who train with TNT all received contributions to help reach their fundraising minimums.

Christina emphasizes that prior to TNT she was not an endurance athlete, and believes that with TNT almost anyone can achieve success. In fact, Christina's mother, inspired by her daughter, joined her in training for and running the Nike Women's half-marathon last fall. Several of Christina's friends have also joined TNT.

TNT's spring training is just beginning. The next local information meeting and kick-off is Saturday, Feb. 2 in Foster City. Go to HikeForDiscovery.org to learn about charity hikes of varying difficulty levels, and go to TeamInTraining.org to learn about other endurance events.

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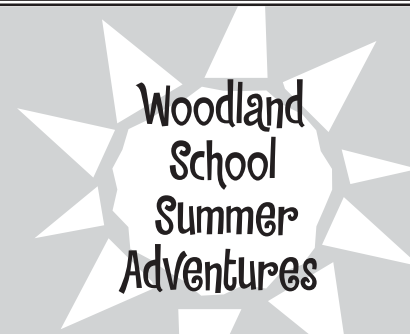

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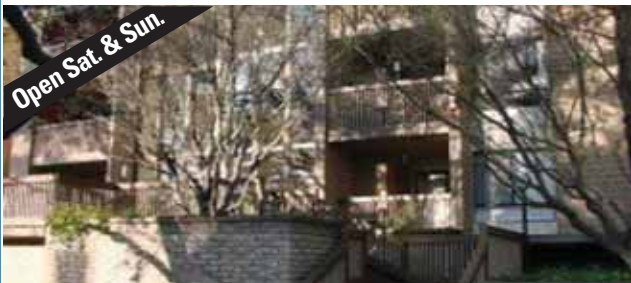
