Bound TO INSPIRE

CSMA'S 'CONCEPTUALLY BOUND' EXHIBIT TAKES BOOKS TO THE NEXT LEVEL

I felt a certain sense of apprehension visiting the current art exhibit at Mountain View's Community School of Music and Arts. To begin with, it's titled "Conceptually Bound," which made me worry it's more conceptual (i.e. inspired by abstract ideas) than aesthetic (i.e. something I can actually recognize as art.)

Happily, my fears were misplaced. Not only are the ideas behind "Conceptually Bound" totally digestible, most of the pieces on display are things you can actually pick up and hold in your hands. Nothing abstract about that.

Showing through May 25 at CSMA's Mohr Gallery, the exhibit — its full title is "Conceptually Bound 3, An Exhibition of Artists' Books" — features books created by about two dozen artists. But

these aren't just ordinary books: They push the interpretation of what a book is, and what a book tells, far beyond convention and into interesting, unusual realms.

No two books on display are even remotely alike. And while many indeed look like typical books, with binding and cover and pages, just as many are either indirectly inspired by the notion of what a book is, or incorporate this notion in playful and inverted ways.

With contributions from artists from North America, Europe and Asia, the books express a variety of perspectives and cultures, some very personal and intimate and others more concerned with larger social issues, like the environment or the Iraq War.

Judith Serebrin's "Soul Book; My Family" is actually a sculpture which represents the faces of each member of her family. And below

each person is a miniature book tucked into the sculpture, as if it contains the personal narrative of each of their lives.

Nearby, another piece titled "Survival Biscuit," by an artist or artists calling themselves "The UPPERCASE Collective II," is an entire table overflowing with cards and small drawings, each bearing different messages and images related to the natural world and environmental crisis. (It's a great work, though the artists should possibly have their naming privileges taken away.)

Part of the enjoyment of this exhibit is that it's OK to handle many of these pieces, as long as visitors wear the cotton gloves provided. Flipping through the pages and feeling the weight of the book in your hands is a tangible pleasure rarely afforded in the glassed-off environment of most



art museums. For this reason, I tended to favor the pieces which told a story in their pages and could only be understood by taking the time to flip through and invest in the narrative.

A particular favorite was Susan O'Malley's "Recent Projects, Products and Services, Volume

Small change

'CAROLINE, OR CHANGE' FEATURES GORGEOUS VOCALS AND STRONG ACTING, BUT A STATIC PLOT

“**C**aroline, Or Change” seems perpetually poised to become a better show.

The new TheatreWorks production is set against a background filled with narrative possibility: the American South in 1963, during the civil rights movement. It has gorgeous vocals, some very fine acting, and a dramatic powerhouse, C. Kelly Wright, in the title role.

Yet the plot never fully takes flight. It's weighed down with lengthy exposition and a pat ending that sap many opportunities for drama and urgency. Characters can seem static and in some cases are underwritten. The story is more of a slice of life, so if you're expecting a compelling narrative, you may be disappointed.

Tony Kushner, who wrote the book and lyrics that are paired with Jeanine Tesori's music, draws on his childhood in Lake Charles, Louisiana, for the setting. His alter ego, young Noah (Julian Hornik), lives with his father, Stuart (Ryan Drummond), and stepmother, Rose (Eileen Tepper), a friend whom Stuart married after Noah's mother died of cancer.

With Stuart still brooding alone with his clarinet, Rose tries her best to befriend Noah. But the

boy wants only to spend time with maid Caroline, who grudgingly lets him light her daily cigarette as she does the laundry.

Meanwhile, outside this home where an African-American maid works for a white Jewish family for \$30 a week, the civil rights movement is growing. Other Jews are activists, and Caroline's daughter Emmie (a delightful Valisia LeKae) is an enthusiastic supporter of the movement. But the only change Caroline sees is the pile of forgotten coins she retrieves from Noah's pants pockets before doing the laundry.

One day, Rose decides to teach Noah a lesson about responsibility: From now on, any change Caroline finds in his laundry she can keep. Caroline balks, but even pocket coins make a difference to this stretched-thin single mother of four. And Noah is pleased to help — at first.

This is basically a small story inside a world filled with drama. Much of the time it doesn't feel like a big enough tale on which to balance an entire show. The situation could teach lessons about pride, guilt and financial inequality, but many of the characters never learn them. There can be meaningful tragedy in a person who cannot or will not change, but here the characters who stand still often just feel flat.

Rose, for example, never understands the havoc she's caused by telling Caroline to “keep the change.” There's a sadness about her clumsy attempts to befriend her maid, and probably a deeper loneliness inside Rose, but the script gives us only glimpses of this. So we end up watching Rose repeatedly mispronouncing Caroline's name, when we'd much rather be following the spirited Emmie onto the barricades.

These limitations are not the fault of the actors or of this high-quality production. Although Tepper can be a bit of a one-note

as the New York fish-out-of-water Rose, she also exudes an earnest vulnerability that is appealing.

Even stronger is Wright's performance as Caroline. She's gripping right from her first moment on stage, toiling in the sweltering basement in her all-white uniform. “Thirty-nine and still a maid,” Wright sings, her every clenched move conveying a thwarted life. When she erupts in rage and frustration, she's mesmerizing.

It's a joy when Caroline lets down her guard for a moment, dreaming of Nat King Cole on a starry night or remembering the

romantic early days of her broken marriage. Her whole face opens up, and on opening night sighs and relieved laughter came from the audience.

Wright's voice is as fervent as her performance, and overall the vocals are a highlight of this production. Hornik's voice is another standout, big and sweet, with an easy vibrato that's far more than precocious.

Kushner has added some nice humor — as well as a sort of Greek chorus — to Caroline's

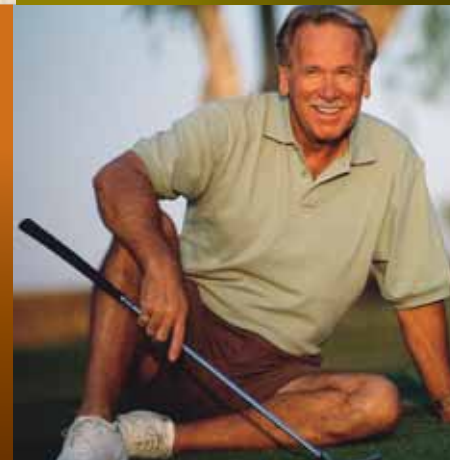

I, Fall 2004-Spring 2005" which documents through text and images a series of experiments involving, of all things, "bubble gum therapy." Truly inspired. I also liked Peng-Peng Wang's "Practical Chinese Conversations for Beginners," which documents the rise and fall of new love through a series of cell phone conversations which the viewer must painstakingly translate from Chinese into English to understand (it's worth the effort, trust me).

And Sun Young Kang's "In Honor of My Grandmother's Simple Life" is a beautiful narrative which, after the fun of bubble gum therapy and breaking up with someone in Chi-

nese, reminds one of the powers of traditional narrative to tell an honest story from the heart.

Far from requiring an art history degree to understand or appreciate, "Conceptually Bound" is a fun, eclectic exhibit with something of interest for nearly anyone. ■

world by making the moon (Anise Ritchie), the washing machine (Allison Blackwell), and the dryer (James Monroe Iglehart) singing players in the musical. When Caroline switches on the radio, it also comes to life in the form of Marsha Lawson, Adrienne Muller and Dawn L. Troupe, all red sequins and girl-group moves.

Iglehart, dapper in red shoes and a matching pocket handkerchief, drew big applause on opening night as the suave Dryer. But he was more powerful as the woeful Bus, mourning the assassinated John F. Kennedy. His voice was rich and sonorous, keening for the lost president and the lost innocence of the time.

Ritchie glowed behind him as the bright full Moon, creating a haunting picture.

If "Caroline, Or Change" is more a string of moments than a compelling story, at least there are some moments that really shine. ■

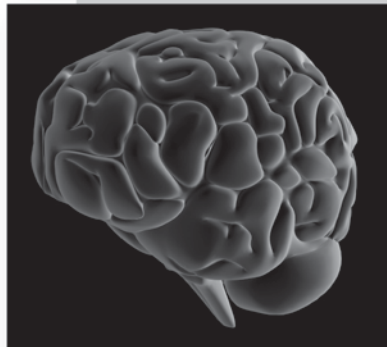

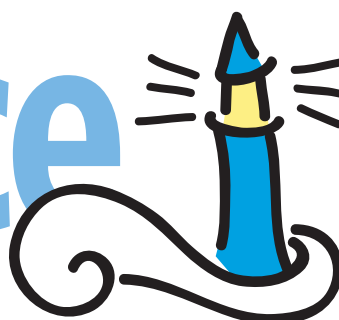
