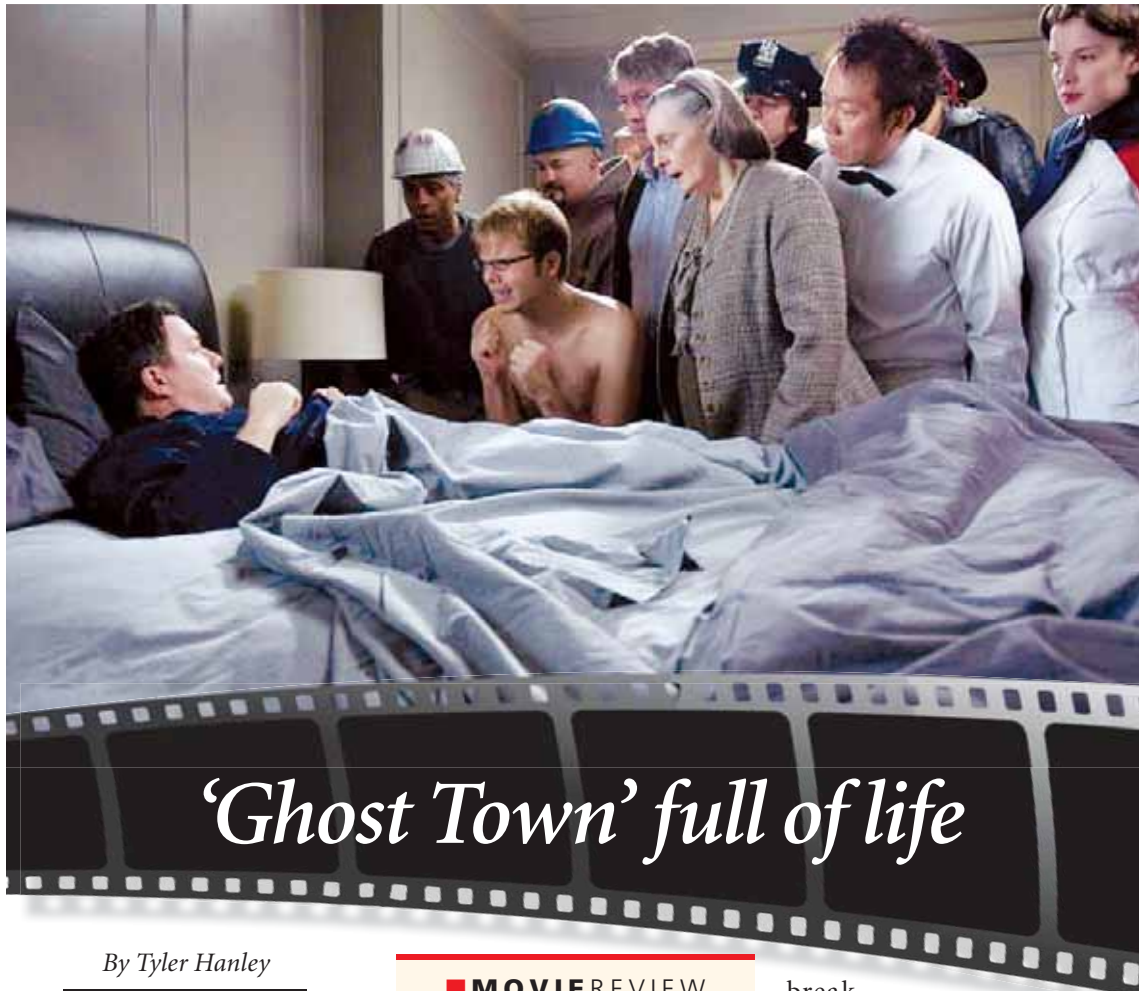

'Ghost Town' full of life

This rib-tickling and heart-felt tale of a man among ghosts finally offers British funnyman Ricky Gervais ("The Office") a chance to shine on the big screen.

"Ghost Town" plays a bit like a blend between the Bill Murray comedy "Groundhog Day" (1993) and the Patrick Swayze tear-jerker "Ghost" (1990). But with the wry yet genuine Gervais in the mix — flanked by fellow comedic actors Greg Kinnear and Tea Leoni — "Ghost Town" has a spirit all its own.

To call dentist Bertram Pincus (Gervais) a "people person" is akin to labeling a couch potato a "go-getter." Bertram prefers to be left alone, stuffing wads

of cotton in the mouth of his talkative patients to avoid conversation or sneaking past a colleague's new-baby celebration. A fluke reaction to a minor surgical procedure leaves Bertram dead for seven minutes. When he comes to, he is remarkably able to see and hear a myriad of ghosts wandering Manhattan.

Seems the specters have unfinished business, especially tuxedo-clad smooth talker Frank Herlihy (Kinnear). Frank is desperate to

break up the pending marriage of his widow, Gwen (Leoni), who happens to live in Bertram's building. As Bertram begrudgingly agrees to help Frank in exchange for solitude and silence, he quickly finds himself falling for Gwen and learning more about the lost lives of the other ghosts seeking his aid.

"Ghost Town" is a fantasy charmer, from its tight cast and excellent soundtrack to its complex characters and soulful climax. Director/co-writer David Koepf — whose last directorial effort was the Johnny Depp chiller "Secret Window" (2004) — helms with a creative consideration too often lacking in Hollywood features. SAM ROCKWELL IS MASTERFUL AS SEX-ADDLED PROTAGONIST

Sam Rockwell proves again (and again and again) that he's a talent to be reckoned with.

What's not to love about a twisted, sex-addicted historical interpreter (i.e. tour guide)

with relentless wit and a big old damaged heart? That's Victor Mancini (Rockwell), who spreads himself razor thin between

gigs at the colonial theme park, weekly addiction workshops and tending to his delusional, sociopathic mother Ida (Anjelica Houston).

Victor's motivations may be skewed — sleeping with mom's doc (Kelly MacDonald) to keep her in his corner and keeping mom alive to establish the identity of his real dad — but he's nothing if not resourceful.

Victor's trying, really trying, to kick that nasty nookie crave; struggling through a pre-established 12-step pro-

gram and hung up somewhere around Step Three because of troublesome issues with intimacy and trust. He flogs himself for faux-choking in public to garner sympathy from Good Samaritans, but it's one day and one step at a time.

Raunchy sex and nudity

accompany a witty, pattering voice-over that utilizes dialogue from Chuck Palahniuk's controversial novel of the same

name. As Victor relentlessly endeavors to "reclaim my booth at the cafe of diminished expectations," he continues to seek approval a la the high-speed chase. Whoa partner.

Actor/director Clark Gregg gives "Choke" an indie slant far less splashy than David Fincher's adaptation of Palahniuk's "Fight Club." When it's all said and done (in Gregg's inimitable style — dark, smart and quirky) Victor emerges a weirdly benevolent protagonist you won't soon forget. ▣

Gervais and Kinnear make an excellent team. Both actors bring humor and sincerity to their roles and play off each other at every turn. Leoni is a terrific addition as well. She digs deep for raw emotion yet radi-

ates a jovial affability.

Two other actors — Kristen Wiig of "Saturday Night Live" and Alan Ruck (best known for his role as Cameron Frye in "Ferris Bueller's Day Off") — are exceptional in secondary roles.

For a film focused on those with a lack of blood flow, "Ghost Town" has a powerful pulse. ▣

MOVIE REVIEWS

BURN AFTER
READING★★★★1/2

(Century 16, Century 20) The Coen Brothers veer a hard left with a humorous and cautionary tale of lust and revenge. Kicking off this comic thriller is a pastiche of prickly players fully invested in their self-absorbed worlds. Osborne Cox (John Malkovich) is a CIA analyst fired for a "drinking problem," at which point he comes totally unglued. His bitchy physician wife, Katie (Tilda Swinton), feels no pain (and little sympathy) as she's banging conflicted U.S. Federal Marshal Harry Pfarrer (George Clooney) on the side. Stage right is Hardbodies Gym, where office manager Linda Litzke (Frances McDormand) is fretting over her insurance company's unwillingness to cough up the dough for elective cosmetic surgery. Hyperactive trainer Chad Feldheimer (Brad Pitt) is her shoulder to cry on, far more brawn than brain. Opportunity knocks when a Hardbodies employee finds a CD of Osborne's scathing tell-all memoirs on the gym's floor. Believing they've struck gold, Chad and Linda attempt to blackmail him, offering to trade the CD for \$50K and blissful dreams of lifts and liposuctions. As usual, the Coens know dark comedy inside and out. *Rated: R for pervasive language, sexual content and violence. A taut 1 hour, 31 minutes.* — J.A.

THE HOUSE BUNNY ★★★

(Century 20) "Revenge of the Nerds" gets a feminine twist in this entertaining and uplifting chuckler. Spearheaded by funny girl Anna Faris, "House Bunny" blends a feel-good story about friendship with tongue-in-cheek humor and a talented cast. Sweet-natured Playboy bunny Shelley Darlington (Faris) gets a rude awakening the morning after her 27th birthday. Seems Hugh Hefner wants her to move out of the Playboy mansion, effective immediately. Shelley's contagious good mood suddenly goes glum as she desperately hunts for a place to live — and a sheltered life of pool parties and cosmopolitans makes the real world feel foreign. Shelley finds acceptance at the sorority house of Zeta Alpha Zeta. The seven members are outcasts, ignored or ridiculed by frat boys and teased by the superficial girls at chichi sorority Phi Iota Mu. The girls of Zeta need to sign a new pledge class or risk losing their charter. As Shelley guides them from socially awkward to uber-popular, she learns her own lessons about individuality and inner beauty. *Rated: PG-13 for sex-related humor, partial nudity and brief strong language. 1 hour, 38 minutes.* — T.H.

LAKEVIEW TERRACE

★★★★1/2

(Century 16, Century 12) A crack cast and chilling performance by psycho stalwart Samuel L. Jackson anchor this smart and suspenseful thriller. Jackson is L.A. cop Abel Turner, an edgy single dad of two whose grip on sanity and the responsibilities of neighborhood watch

is a tad tight. New neighbors Chris and Lisa Mattson (Patrick Wilson and Kerry Washington) find out the hard way. Abel doesn't take kindly to their biracial coupling and makes it known in a number of intimidating ways: security lights shining in windows, noisy late-night parties and ethnic slurs evocative of the racist gold-standard film "Crash." The Mattsons steadfastly cling to their politically correct cocoon, refusing to apply significance where there may be none. Ultimately the situation unravels and they crest a breaking point, turning home front into battle front. *Rated: PG-13 for language, violence and mature themes. 1 hour, 46 minutes. J.A.*

MAN ON WIRE ★★★★★

(Aquarius) With breathtaking harmony James Marsh balances tempo, humor and passion in the re-telling of high-wire artist Philippe Petit's stunning walk across New York's City's Twin Towers. From a tender age Petit had a dream, the as-yet-unfinished World Trade Center Towers galloping in his brain as the object of an unquenchable quest. In the early '70s the cat-like Petit and a ragtag bunch of friends set about a plan that would rock their world, testing cables, wires and provocative schemes to string a tightrope between a pair of monumental skyscrapers. The group dummied up fake invoices and ID cards, and with Lady Luck on their side got themselves and their accoutrement to the top of the North and South Towers in August of 1974. There Petit's destiny is sealed. With the help of captivating interviews, fresh re-creation and astonishing archival footage and photos, Petit's journey becomes an emotional roller coaster, fraught with danger. Outrageously entertaining and perfectly profound. *Rated: PG-13 for brief nudity and mature themes. 1 hour, 40 minutes. In English and French with English subtitles. — J.A.*

PINEAPPLE EXPRESS

★★★1/2
(Century 16, Century 20) James Franco is Saul Silver, an affable hey-dude pusher of the dopest dope who finds himself in hot water when one of his clients witnesses a murder. Said customer is Dale Denton (Seth Rogen), a schlumpy twenty-something process server with a high-school girlfriend and an affinity for the weed. Parked outside the home of the city's most notorious dealer (and prepped to deliver yet another subpoena), Denton sees his client and a female cop (Rosie Perez) waste a Chinese kingpin with ruthless brutality. Denton makes a ruckus and throws his half-smoked doobie to the pavement before taking off in a panic. Unfortunately that particular brand of herb (Pineapple Express, don'tcha know) is traced straight back to Silver. What begins as a token action-comedy turns pure buddy pic as Denton and Silver engage in a ludicrous odyssey-slash-comedy of errors to escape the drug lords who want their heads on a platter. Translation: a raunchy blend of car chases, sex play, gun battles and lots and lots of pot. *Rated R for language, drug use, sexual reference and violence. 1 hour, 52 minutes. — J.A.*

STAR WARS: THE CLONE WARS ★1/2

(Century 20) This latest big-screen treatment of the Star Wars universe is by far its most disappointing. With animation that would be better suited to a high-end video game or special presentation on the Cartoon Network, "Star Wars: The Clone Wars" is riddled with lackluster dialogue and retreat scenarios. The story essentially takes place between "Attack of the Clones" and "Revenge of the Sith." Tensions continue to escalate between the Republic (with the Jedi council on its side) and the Separatists, led by the villainous Count Dooku (voice of Christopher Lee). Amidst the chaos, Anakin Skywalker (voice of Matt Lanter) must mentor a Padawan (Jedi-in-training) named Ahsoka Tano (voice of Ashley Eckstein). Anakin and Ahsoka are ordered by Jedi master Yoda to rescue and return the kidnapped young son of slovenly mobster Jabba the Hutt. Jabba could become a valuable ally to the Republic and getting in his good graces is a priority for the Jedi. As Anakin and

Ahsoka battle to save the pint-sized "huttlet," Dooku schemes surreptitious plans of his own. Seeing some classic Star Wars aliens re-imagined in 3-D animation is a treat. But overall, the force just isn't with "Clone Wars." *Rated: PG for sci-fi action violence throughout, brief language and momentary smoking. 1 hour, 30 minutes — T.H.*

TRAITOR ★★★

(Century 16, Century 12) Unlike Jason Bourne of the "Bourne Identity" series, Samir Horn knows exactly who he is: a devout Muslim, first and foremost. The tension in writer-director Jeffrey Nachmanoff's international thriller results from the fact that neither we nor the other characters know exactly what that means. The CIA and FBI think the former U.S. Special Operations officer may be providing explosives to Islamic terrorists. The Islamic jihadists wonder if the American Muslim can be trusted. Only Don Cheadle knows, and he's playing Samir Horn close to the vest. The narrative leaks information on a need-to-know

basis, slowly developing Horn's character and our curiosity. As a child, he witnessed his father's death by car bomb in Sudan. As an adult, the ex-military explosives expert tends to materialize — and then vanish — at the scene of incendiary incidents in Yemen, Nice and London. With that profile, no wonder FBI agents Clayton (Guy Pearce) and Archer (Neal McDonough) and are on his trail. As an espionage thriller, "Traitor" delivers. The jihadists want to convince Americans that no one is safe. Ironically, "Traitor" turns on itself and instills that fear in the viewer. *Rated: PG-13 for intense violent sequences, thematic material and brief language. 1 hour 50 minutes. — S.T.*

THE WOMEN ★★

(Century 16, Century 20) Ten years in the making and simply dripping with feminist chic, "The Women" goes for the gusto in the screen goddess sweepstakes. Mary Haines (Meg Ryan) is the kind of woman others loves to hate. Between high-profile volunteering gigs, Mary chums around with best buddy Sylvia Fowler (Annette

Bening), a glamorous, influential magazine editor. Mary and Sylvia consider Edie Cohen (Debra Messing) an integral part of their set and Edie miraculously manages a go-girls social life between popping out babies and caring for her growing brood. Rounding out the fab four is Alex Fisher (Jada Pinkett Smith), a ballsy gay author struggling with her second book. No males to be found, but they're up front and center in spirit. Mary's husband Stephen is having an affair with a Saks Fifth Avenue "spritzer girl" (Eva Mendes) and her pals are having none of it, setting out to win back Stephen's cheating heart. Messy construction, trite themes and an endless parade of verbal chestnuts can't hide the fact that the women of "Women" are having fun. *Rated: PG-13 for language, sexuality and mature themes. 1 hour, 54 minutes. — J.A.*

CALL FOR ARTISTS

THE CITY OF MOUNTAIN VIEW'S VISUAL ARTS COMMITTEE IS SEEKING BAY AREA SOLO OR COLLECTIVE ARTISTS TO EXHIBIT PUBLIC ART IN THE LOBBY OF THE CENTER FOR THE PERFORMING ARTS DURING THE YEAR 2009.

The City of Mountain View's Visual Arts Committee is seeking Bay Area solo or collective artists to exhibit public art in the lobby of the Center for the Performing Arts during the year 2009.

The rotating exhibits are approximately nine weeks in length and are viewed by up to 25,000 people. The Committee particularly wants to encourage exhibits by professional artists and can only accept two-dimensional media. The City will provide insurance, some advertising, installation and offers a small stipend to help defray costs.

Artists should submit a one page résumé and 10 digital photos in JPEG format (JPG) of their artwork by Friday, October 17, 2008 to: joanne.saucedo@mountainview.gov or mail to the Community Development Department, 500 Castro Street, Mountain View, California 94041. Do not put application materials in notebooks or binders. If your submittal does not meet the digital formatting requirements, it will not be honored as an official submittal and will not be reviewed.

For exhibition purposes, the Committee asks that a major portion of the work that is shown in the application be available for the exhibit and appropriate for the space, both in size and subject matter. 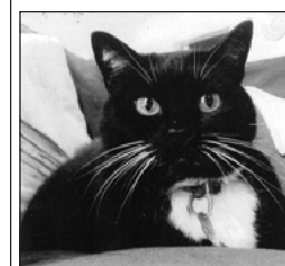

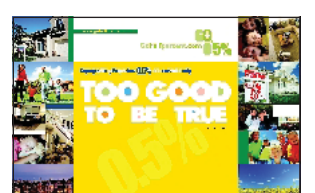

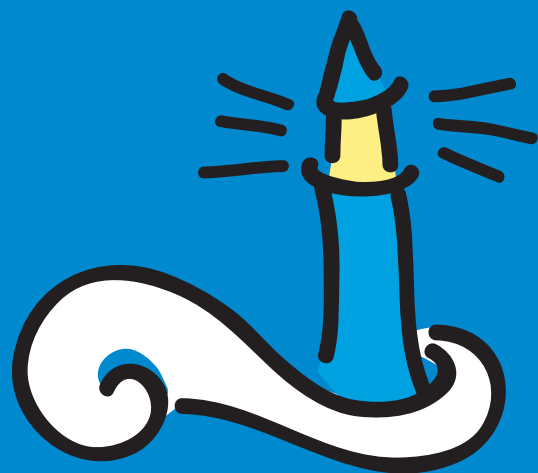
