Run from HOLIDAY WEIGHT GAIN

THE HOLIDAY SEASON IS A TRYING TIME ON THE BODY, BUT EXPERTS HAVE TIPS ON STAYING HEALTHY

First, it was the Tootsie Rolls, the Reese's Peanut Butter Cups and the mini Snickers. Next comes the stuffing, the gravy and the pumpkin pie. Then, an entire month of sugar cookies, liquor-drenched parties and family dinners.

It's an all-out assault on your healthy eating and weight loss plan — and it won't let up for another six weeks.

Studies have shown that the average American gains one to two pounds every holiday season. But there are ways to fight the yo-yo of December weight gain and January gym obsession. Armed with some tips from local experts, you might just fit into your favorite party outfit come New Year's Eve.

El Camino Hospital dietician Kim Bandelier's top strategy is to cut way back on alcohol. "You're just drinking empty calories," she said.

Even worse, a little tipsiness can dissolve your self control when it comes to all the snacks and treats at a party. To

combat this double-whammy, she suggests, chose a couple parties where you can splurge; then, commit to having just one drink and being a designated driver at the others.

Avoiding the land mines of holiday eating requires a rethinking of some common bad habits. First, don't skip meals, said Rachel Freiberg, behavioral health educator and dietitian at PAMF.

"People think, 'I'm going to eat a lot later,' and skip breakfast." This backfires, she said, because you're starving

TEN TIPS FOR HEALTHY HOLIDAY EATING

1. MAKE A PLAN before holiday get-togethers where food is served, and stick to it.

2. HAVE A LIGHT SNACK before going to holiday parties so you aren't starving when you arrive. Conversely, avoid skipping meals so you can "eat more at the party."

3. MAKE IT YOUR GOAL to maintain your weight during the holidays, instead of trying to lose weight afterwards.

4. EAT A SMALL PORTION of your favorite seasonal foods and sweets occasionally. If you deprive yourself of your once-a-year favorites, you will only increase the temptation to overeat later out of frustration.

5. EAT SLOWLY and pay close attention to how much is on your plate. Learn the art of saying, "No thank you, I'm full."

6. AVOID OR LIMIT ALCOHOL and cocktails, as they are full of calories. Too much alcohol also tends to loosen inhibitions, including those that keep you from overeating.

7. KEEP HOLIDAY FOOD TRADITIONS such as baking that are important to you. Just make half the recipe and give away or toss any high-calorie leftovers so that they are out of your immediate environment.

8. PLAN HOLIDAY ACTIVITIES that will get you moving instead of eating, such as going ice-skating or dancing. Exercise also reduces holiday stress that can lead to overeating.

9. CARRY A TRAVEL TOOTHBRUSH, gum or mints with you to holiday parties. The clean feeling they leave behind will help prevent you from nibbling at goodies when you are ready to stop eating.

10. STOCK UP ON FRUITS and veggies that travel well, such as oranges, apples, pears, bananas, carrots, celery and peppers. This way, you will always have a healthy snack close at hand to help you resist eating too many of the unhealthy alternatives.

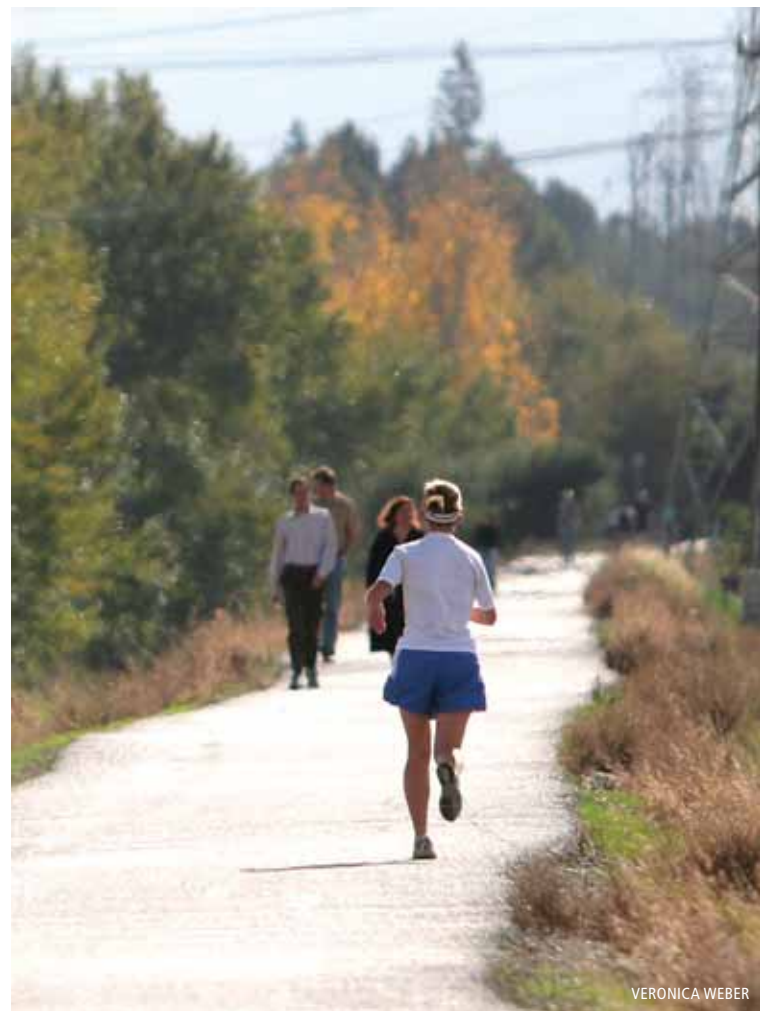

when you get to the party or meal and gorge on high-fat items, like cookies, that won't satisfy you.

Instead, have a plan. Eat a healthy snack before the party so you aren't ravenous, said Freiberg. At a buffet or family-

with fruits and veggies, she said.

Bandelier agrees that setting priorities and budgeting your calories is key. At Thanksgiving, for instance, decide ahead of time which items are your favorites. "If stuffing is your favorite, make that the main part of your meal." Then limit yourself to small portions of a few other items, and don't go back for seconds, she said.

Once you've gotten small servings of your must-have treats, fill the rest of your plate with fruits and veggies.

style meal, check out all the dishes before putting anything on your plate.

"Scope it all out and decide where you want to spend your calories," she said. "Be choosy. Even a bite or two of everything can add up." Once you've gotten small servings of your must-have treats, fill the rest of your plate

A fear of wasting food is another barrier to healthy holiday eating. Both Bandelier and Frieberg said it's important to get past that. If you take a bite of a cookie and it doesn't taste great, don't take another bite, Bandelier said.

RotaCare gets \$85,000 grant

FREE CLINIC TO USE FUNDS TO HELP PATIENTS MANAGE CHRONIC DISEASE

Doctors and nurses at the RotaCare free clinic at El Camino Hospital will now be able to help uninsured patients manage their chronic illnesses with the help of an \$85,000 grant the clinic received earlier this week.

Palo Alto Medical Foundation, a Sutter Health affiliate, presented the grant to clinic officials during a small ceremony this week. Barbara Avery, the hospital's manager of community development, said the additional funding will go toward teaching 120 patients with chronic diseases — such as high blood pressure, diabetes and asthma — how to maintain healthy lifestyles.

"We can get patients stabi-

lized," Avery said. "We can get patients the medications they need."

Approximately 70 percent of patients who come to RotaCare have at least one chronic illness, according to Avery. The grant will target patients with multiple diseases, and during a year-long program the clinic's nurse practitioner will give the patients tips on how to reduce stress and eat nutritiously.

"We will take the people who are sickest," she said.

This is the first time the hospital and the Sutter Health affiliate have paired up to help the clinic. Palo Alto Medical Foundation spokesperson Cynthia Greaves said it's an important gift "given how much need there is even in our relatively wealthy community."

The grant will also fund a pilot screening program that will allow doctors and nurses to catch these chronic illnesses early.

"If we can catch it early, patients won't become as sick," Avery said.

Sutter Health is awarding \$2.5 million in grants to medical and dental clinics throughout Northern California that work with low-income patients.

The RotaCare clinic is open Mondays and Wednesdays from 5:30 to 9 p.m. and located across from El Camino Hospital at 2400 Grant Road in Mountain View. Call (650) 988-8200 or visit www.rotacarebayarea.org for more information. ■

Since holiday traditions are so ingrained in some families, it can be an emotional battle to avoid eating, say, Aunt Gertie's green bean casserole. But it is possible to avoid hurting feelings without ruining your eating plan. Take just a tiny portion of the casserole, and don't make a big deal out of it, said Freiberg. "You have to eat for you."

As for food gifts, don't be afraid to re-gift or even throw it out, said Frieberg. Better to waste some food than to eat something you don't really want, gain weight and feel lousy.

What if you're the type who can indulge during the holidays and take those few pounds right back off in January? No good, said Bandelier.

Yo-yo dieting can slow down your metabolism, making the weight loss harder each year, she said. And when you gain weight, the number of fat cells in your body increases. Those fat cells increase or decrease in size depending on your eating and exercise habits, but their number will never decrease except through surgical removal, she said. ■

BODY OF LIES ★★★
 (Century 16, Century 20) Entrenched CIA operative Roger Ferris (Leonardo DiCaprio) travels from Iraq to Jordan to hunt down violent fundamentalist Al-Saleem (Alon Abutbul), who is eager to punish infidels in the name of Allah. Ferris' superior in the U.S. is pompous Ed Hoffman (Russell Crowe). Ferris connects with Jordan security chief Hani (British actor Mark Strong) to help keep tabs on a terrorist safehouse. Hani, too, is anxious to bring down Al-Saleem, but his methods strike a contrast to those of Ferris: Torture is fair game to Hani and deceit is unforgivable. *Rated: R for strong violence including torture, and for language. 2 hours, 8 minutes.* — T.H.)

CHANGELING ★★★1/2
 (Century 16, Century 20) Angelina Jolie plays Christine Collins, a single mother raising her son Walter (Gattlin Griffith) alone. One weekend, she agrees to take a co-worker's shift at the telephone company. She returns home to an empty house. Christine's concern escalates into a controlled panic, fueled by frustration and fear. File a missing-child report? Wait 24 hours. Challenge the LAPD when Captain Jones (Jeffrey Donovan) produces a "son" who isn't hers? Intimidate Christine into playing along, so the cesspool of a police force gets some good publicity. Then deem her a hysterical woman and toss her into the county loony bin. Meanwhile, the pages are flying off the calendar. And Walter is nowhere to be found. *Rated: R for some violent and disturbing content, and language. 2 hours, 20 minutes.* — S.T.

Once sans bicycle she determines to learn to drive, and turns to the Axle School of Motoring whose wrathful instructor Scott (Eddie Marsan) arrives full of piss and vinegar. Poppy wants everyone to be upbeat along with her and that's a tall order. Her incessant cheer delicately masks a bruised soul that her 30-year-old single self refuses to acknowledge: a sparse loneliness of tentative depth. *Rated: R for language, some nudity and mature themes. 1 hour, 58 minutes.* — J.A.
