

## Do-your-own wedding fairs set 2009 trend

*'Wedding universities' spawn creative ideas, seminars for savvy brides and grooms*

In a down economy, it may take boosting one's wedding I.Q. to get what couples want on a recessionary budget.

The trend in bridal fairs this year, at least locally, is toward educating rather than inundating, bridal experts said.

On March 1, the "DIY Wedding" (Do It Yourself) will take place at the Palo Alto Crowne Plaza Cabana Hotel. The fair will include perennial wedding fair staples such as a fashion show, food tastings and vendor booths. But, a panel of experts will teach couples how to do some of the work themselves while maintaining their budget — and their sanity.

The event was put together

with the help of Stacie Tamaki, of the Flirty Guide online wedding site, who enlisted experts to share some of their information.

The fair will also focus on "green" weddings, and a custom-cocktail creation lounge by Square One Organic Spirits and Cort Event Furnishings. Floral ideas, music, transportation, cakes and other wedding necessities will be shown to help couples create the perfect wedding.

Another day-long interactive educational affair, "The Wedding University," took place on Feb. 8 at the Four Seasons Hotel Silicon Valley in East Palo Alto. The brainchild of local wedding planners Jean Marks and Jubilee Lau, The Wedding



**Music from the heart**

*"Heartstrings" players provide sweet soundtracks*

More than flowers or candlelight, music sets the mood for love. Perhaps no one knows that better than Al Fabrizio and Hugo Wainzinger, two local musicians who specialize in romantic tunes.

The two are the founders of Heartstrings Music ([www.heartstringsmusic.com](http://www.heartstringsmusic.com)), a Mountain View-based recording studio. Fabrizio plays the mandolin and Wainzinger the guitar — in addition to a host of other instruments.

The tremolo capacity of the mandolin makes it especially suited for romantic music because of the emotion it conveys. And Wainzinger's fluid guitar stylings can turn even the heaviest rock song "into the sweetest stuff," Fabrizio said.

The two put out their first recording in the mid 1990s and eventually decided to pursue their music full time. Though they devote considerable time and energy to working in the studio, their primary source of music income is their live performances.

One of their specialties — not surprising given their romantic sounds and name — is wedding performances.

"We love weddings," Fabrizio said, adding one reason his and Wainzinger's act is popular is their range in repertoire. The two have knowledge of many types of music — Italian, Jewish, Latin, Eastern European and more — making them well-suited for the often multi-cultural weddings around the Bay Area.

Their ability to switch seamlessly from classical to classic rock is also a valuable asset, Wainzinger said, breaking into a surprisingly soft rendition of a Metallica song. "Some guys, they love that melody," he said with a grin.

Playing a mix of song styles makes sure everyone — young and old alike — can relate to and enjoy the music, he said.

Their music has even helped smooth things out at weddings when the bride and groom's families weren't exactly getting along. "Music can save an occasion," Fabrizio said.

Just as their set lists contain an unexpected amount of non-traditional choices, they're open-minded about where to perform. "We've performed at several gay weddings. We're open to any kind. If anybody wants to get married, we'll give them music," Wainzinger said.

Fabrizio, a New York native, and Wainzinger, who hails from Argentina, have been playing music together since 1992. They have a particular fondness for traditional Italian songs, as well as the music of Latin America, but enjoy playing a wide variety of songs and genres, including heavy metal and pop. They've released four records so far.

In their Old Middlefield Road studio, Wainzinger also records and produces albums for other artists — primarily world, jazz and folk music — and composes original songs.

When hired for a wedding, Fabrizio and Wainzinger make choosing the music a collaborative effort. "People come to us with ideas and we make suggestions also. We're open to working with the personalities of

the wedding party. Some people have a sense of humor, others like to keep it old-fashioned and classical," Wainzinger said.

"We'll play during the ceremony, the reception and the dinner. DJs usually take over after that so then we eat and go home," Fabrizio said with a laugh.

In a time of economic hardship, when people may be cutting back on other expenses, Fabrizio said demand for their live performances remains strong. "People always need live music. It brings happiness," Wainzinger said.

The duo's love of music and enthusiasm for sharing it makes their connection with the crowd an essential part of their performances. "We try to read the faces in the audience," Wainzinger said. "And we have fun." ■

University featured three different "classrooms" offering seminar topics, including the secrets of designing a beautiful and personalized wedding; the impact of music at a wedding and the first dance instruction; what to consider with photography and videography; how to select the perfect wedding gown and accessories; learning to manage a wedding budget and event flow; and keys to designing a delectable wedding menu.

Presenters discussed tough economic times and what that means for engaged couples trying to budget a wedding.

"It's unique in the idea of focusing on educational seminars rather than having (the bride-to-be) feel overwhelmed," Marks, founder of Jean Marks Weddings in Palo Alto, said.

Added Lau, "The number one question I get asked is, 'How much is my wedding going to cost?' The reality is that it's different for every couple." ■

### Six to twelve months

- Contract wedding consultant

- Select wedding gown, accessories, attendants' attire, formal wear
- Order wedding rings
- Contract caterer and florist
- Contract photographer, videographer and musicians

### Four to six months

- Order invitations
- Choose wedding cake
- Register for wedding gifts
- Make arrangements for rehearsal dinner
- Arrange event insurance if required
- Arrange wedding transportation

- Enjoy family and guests as they arrive
- Have rehearsal
