## Earth Baby, baby

MOUNTAIN VIEW COMPANY SEEKS TO REPLACE PLASTIC DIAPERS WITH GREENER OPTION

Tired of sending diaper after plastic diaper to the landfills, a group of Mountain View parents-turned-entrepreneurs is hoping to change the way we dispose of our children's nappies.

To accomplish this, Marc Taubert, Mark Siminoff and Karen Nelson recently launched Earth Baby, a compostable diaper service which delivers new diapers straight to clients' homes, then picks up soiled ones to be taken to a local compost center. Still in its early stages, Earth Baby serves 100 families in Santa Clara, San Mateo and Santa Cruz counties. But founders hope that, once their business kicks off, many more Bay Area parents will say good-bye forever to plastic diapers.

"Cloth is already out there," Nelson said. "We wanted something

that was easier."

Taubert, a father of two small children, was taking out his garbage last year when he realized how many plastic diapers his family was throwing away each week.

"Right there he said, enough is enough," Nelson said.

He joined forces with Siminoff, also a Mountain View resident, and Nelson, of Santa Cruz. In September, the three launched a pilot version of Earth Baby, and opened their doors to the public December.

According to Earth Baby's calcula-

tions, there are 70,000 babies in the Bay Area, using as many as 350 million diapers annually.

"That is 350 million diapers going to landfills each year, just from the Bay Area," Nelson said. "We are trying to reduce that amount."

For \$25 a month plus additional fees for the diapers, the company makes weekly drop offs and picks ups. The diapers are made from corn-based plastic which, unlike oil-based plastics, "completely breaks down," Nelson said. They are taken to a certified compost center in Santa Clara County, and within four months, the diapers are fully composted and turned into topsoil for landscaping and golf courses.

"I felt awful about diapers going into the landfills," said Mountain View resident Lauren Angello, who uses Earth Baby. "Compost may be even better than cloth." ■

## The Cisco secret

COMPANY EXEC EXPLAINS HOW NETWORKING SOFTWARE AND SITES CAN INCREASE REVENUE

How did Cisco add \$240 million to its bottom line over the last two years?

Last week, Sameer Khera, senior director of IT, told the Bay Area IT/Software Development Execs Meetup Group about Cisco's initiatives in collaboration and communication. Three essential technologies have helped Cisco become more productive: video, wikis and social networking.

Cisco acquired WebEx in May 2007, which enables video conferencing, webinars and webcasts for both individuals and organizations. For more lifelike video, Cisco's TelePresence systems show remote groups on large screens as if they were sitting round the same

table. An executive can have a personal TelePresence screen in the office to communicate with people from afar.

Video has helped Cisco reduce travel costs by \$61 million. Video demos also help close sales. Even the smallest businesses can use a video camera to put a demo on Google's YouTube, or collaborate using Google Video.

Ciscopedia is Cisco's internal version of Wikipedia, the online encyclopedia which now has over 2.7 million articles. Ciscopedia helps employees collaborate and connect. Employees have their own pages, like in Facebook, to promote their expertise.

At the Meetup, Lisa Burns chimed in from the audience, suggesting Jive's Clearspace as a collaborative platform for businesses that want to combine wikis and social networking. When sales forces can collaborate they can accelerate the sales cycle.

Check out some Wikis. Find artwork on Wikimedia, look up words in Wiktionary or learn at Wikiversity. Webmasters, consider using wiki technology so you aren't the only person

updating Web pages. You can download Wiki software such as MediaWiki, PMWiki or Moin-Moin. If you are not technical and want to set up collaboration for a small business, then Google Apps is an option (google.com/apps). Google Sites (not Google Page Creator) is an easy way for a small group to make a Web site.

According to Khera, Cisco CIO Rebecca Jacoby likens the company's IT initiatives to "Facebook for the Enterprise." If you aren't on Facebook, it's time to give it a try. Create a page that promotes your business on Facebook.

Last year, Jason Alba spoke at Fenwick and West about his book "I'm on Facebook — Now What???" Before the talk, I used Facebook to keep in touch with my nieces. During the talk, I learned how people used Facebook to follow industry trends, test ideas and make business connections. After the talk, I widened my list of Facebook contacts.

Then again, do you really need Facebook if you use Mountain View's LinkedIn? LinkedIn, with over 36 million members, is still my preferred choice for asking business questions, finding jobs and getting referrals. Facebook, meanwhile, is about marketing yourself and sharing your ideas. If you don't have a board of

directors, you can be accountable to your Facebook friends.

The Bay Area IT/Software Development Execs Meetup Group is an IT networking group, led by former PricewaterhouseCoopers consultant Tatyana Kanzaveli. This informal group of IT managers, consultants and software entrepreneurs

meets in the Samovar Conference Hall on Independence Avenue. (An industrial area venue, Samovar is a refreshing alternative space for business or social meetings, providing homemade Russian food (www.bestrussianfood.com) and wine, as well as audiovisual equipment.)

# Low income, high potential

GLOW FOUNDATION GIVES GUIDANCE, SCHOLARSHIPS TO STUDENTS NEEDING IT MOST

Imagine you're one of the 28 million Americans who lack access to traditional financial services. For financial transactions, your family relies on payday loans, check-cashing services and pawnshops rather than checking and savings accounts or lines of credit. Meanwhile, you've worked hard in school and, despite the odds against it, been the first person in your family admitted to college.

This may sound like the American dream come true, until you're hit with a tuition bill of \$10,000 or more — after you've already maxed out on financial aid provided by your college and the government. Your family has no or bad credit and therefore can't qualify for loans, and no one in your family has ever applied to college and so cannot give you advice on obtaining scholarships.

What do you do? If you're lucky, you connect with the Glow Foundation, which provides financial education, mentoring and scholarships to high-potential, low-income students.

Prior to starting Glow, founder Adam Marchick mentored a low-income student who beat the odds by succeeding in high school, getting into college and applying for and obtaining financial aid. However, the student nearly ended up joining the military instead due to a \$500 gap between what his family could afford and the amount of his financial aid (Marchick ended up writing the \$500 check himself).

This struggle was not an isolated occurrence, Marchick learned. Every year in the U.S., an estimated 200,000 college-ready high school students do not pursue higher learning because of financial barriers. A student with a D grade point average from a high-income family has the same probability of enrolling in college as a student with an A grade point average from a low-income family. Marchick determined to do something to help change these statistics, so he started Glow.

Glow Scholars are high school seniors who participate in financial education classes, develop their own budget, apply for existing scholarships and com-

pete for "unmet need" funding. Many scholars are also paired with mentors to help them complete these tasks.

Mountain View resident Ali Zuckerbrow has been a Glow mentor for the past two years. She meets with her student once or twice a month to help her fill out college applications and financial aid forms. She also helps her use online search



tools to find and apply for appropriate scholarships.

"It's inspiring to see these students realize their goals and dreams. I also really enjoy attending the end-of-year workshops with all the Glow Scholars; it's great to see them so happy now that they have been accepted to college and know that they can afford it," says Zuckerbrow.

Founded in 2006, Glow has been expanding rapidly. This year, the number of students in the program has doubled from 100 to 200. Amazingly, Glow has successfully scaled up its staff and volunteers. The main challenge is increasing funding enough to continue to provide the "unmet need" grants to ensure that the scholars who complete the program will be able to afford college even if their financial aid packages fall a bit short.

To that end, Glow is holding its first annual Glow Scholar Dinner on April 18, from 6 to 9 p.m. at the Sheraton in Palo Alto. Tickets are \$100, and attendees will each go home with a \$50 gift certificate to the spa at the Four Seasons, as well as the satisfaction of knowing that their financial contribution will be leveraged into many more scholarship dollars.

#### UWINK RESTAURANT CHAIN STRUGGLES FINANCIALLY

Suffering from “serious liquidity issues,” according to analysts, uWink has officially removed itself from the stock market after its share price hovered around zero for months.

The restaurant chain, started by Atari and Chuck-E-Cheese founder Nolan Bushnell, has a location on Castro Street. Although business there has not always been booming, the current problems are company-wide.

There is some hope for uWink, however, as it is beginning to sell its technology to other restaurants. Its table-top touch screens, which feature video games, interactive media and automated menus for ordering food, can lower a restaurant’s labor costs by eliminating wait staff, the company said in a press release.

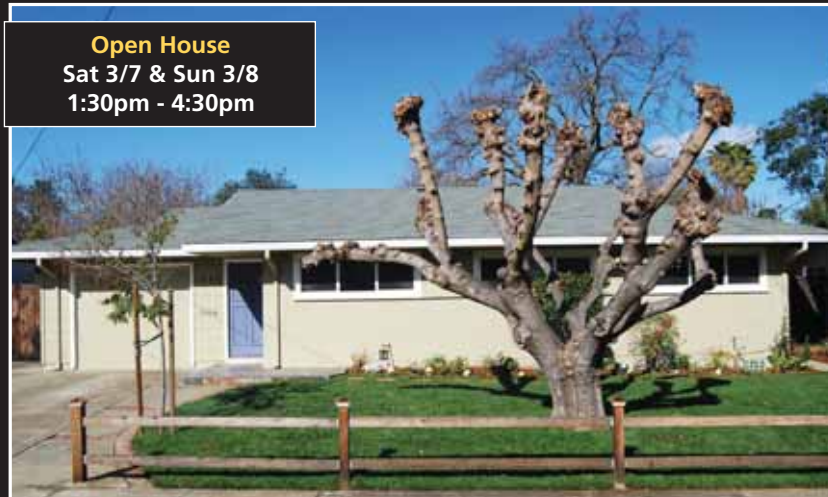

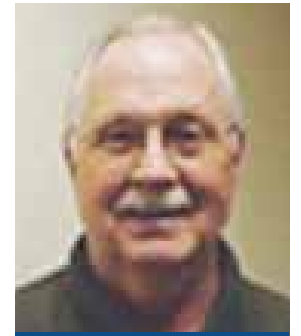

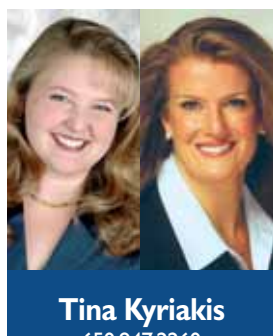
