Thankless work for 'Sunshine Cleaning'

DESPITE FINE PERFORMANCES BY AMY ADAMS AND EMILY BLUNT, OFF-KEY DRAMEDY NEVER QUITE FINDS ITS NICHE

Amy Adams packs her winning charm in this ultra-quirky dramedy about fielding life's curveballs.

Rose Norkowski (Adams) is between a rock and hard spot: shacking up with ex-high school squeeze and married cop Mac (Steve Zahn), raising a kid on her own and wasting her shiny potential by cleaning houses for a living.

A chance suggestion by Mac (after a particularly unsavory day on the job) turns to gold when Rose partners with sister Norah (Emily Blunt) to start her own crime-scene clean-up company, aptly named Sunshine Cleaning. If gory biohazard removal isn't a growth industry, then what is?

The frustrations pile on fast and furious: Norah's reluctance to cope with

life's tough realities (and body parts), finding precious spare time for a certification in blood-borne pathogens (affectionately known as BBP), and coping with a feisty, huckster dad (Alan Arkin reprising his "Little Miss Sunshine" routine) who's perpetually one scheme away from making it.

The expected conventions are all in place: a mysterious childhood tragedy, a surprising love interest (the always intriguing Clifton Collins Jr.) and the challenges of single parenting. Adams has the chops, bringing a fresh spin to deep hurts and a spark to her determination to get things right. Blunt plays off her with ease — two hot actresses on their inevitable paths to greatness. But the narrative has trouble balancing its dark tones and its peculiar humor, never finding a comfortable niche.

The climax is an unnecessary stretch for a happy ending, cashing in on the same production company's "Sunshine" (are we sensing a theme here?) and its electric box-office success.

The simplicity of 'Duplicity'

JULIA ROBERTS AND CLIVE OWEN ARE FUN TO LOOK AT BUT SUPERFICIAL, JUST LIKE THE MOVIE ITSELF

With her ear-to-ear grin and signature laugh, Julia Roberts amps up the star wattage as a smart-and-sexy spy who goes undercover for the CIA — and gets under the covers with the MI6 operative played by Clive Owen. The competing agents trade wisecracks and kisses with an onscreen chemistry that adds plenty of sizzle to Tony Gilroy's caper movie.

Just don't expect any steak.

Writer-director Gilroy's second foray into the "Michael Clayton" world of corporate corruption is a lighthearted romp of very little substance. Attractive stars and visuals, witty banter and a fragmented narrative obscure the simple premise: Can anyone be trusted these days, including the one you love?

The convoluted narrative can be confusing as it swoops, swerves, zigs and zags through time and place. CIA operative

secrets and secure the patents for the next big product — and for the two career spies to keep their growing personal relationship clandestine. They relish being "very good at being very bad" (sexual innuendo intended).

As in the Bourne franchise, also scripted by Gilroy, the action goes back and forth in time and circles the globe: Rome, Miami, Zurich. Oscar-winning cinematographer Robert Elswit's ("There Will Be Blood") interior and exterior shots are fit for a travel brochure. Part of the pleasure of watching this film is the voyeuristic experience of taking in the view from an industry titan's high-rise office or gazing at the decor of a five-star luxury hotel suite.

"Duplicity" rides on spectacle, the moment-to-moment appeal of eye-catching images and appealing stars. At the end, the smoke and mirrors give way to reveal who is gaming whom. And what does it matter? Instead of feeling satisfied and enjoying the payoff, watchers get an empty experience. The viewer is the one who gets duped

Claire Stenwick (Roberts) first meets and sleeps with rival Ray Koval (Owen) in Dubai. Five years later, the pretty woman runs into him again in New York City. They have left their government gigs to conduct intelligence work for corporate competitors Howard Tully (Tom Wilkinson) and Dick Garsik (Paul Giamatti). The stakes are high to steal industry

THE CLASS ★★★★★

(Guild) Director Laurent Cantet's drama looks like a documentary but isn't one. Shot in cinema-verite style and starring actual French high school students, the film fuses fiction and fact. Francois Begaudeau adapted his autobiographical novel about teaching in the multi-racial 20th arrondissement of Paris into a screenplay — and plays the French-language teacher named Francois. The film has a slice-of-life feel, as though a fly on the wall captured the complexities of teaching and learning in today's ethnically and economically diverse classroom. Like an exceptional teacher, "The Class" presents complex ideas in a clear, accessible and entertaining way. Cantet's success in tackling such sensitive, topical subject matter earns top marks. *Rated: PG-13. In French with English subtitles. 2 hours. 8 minutes. — S.T.*

THE CURIOUS CASE OF BENJAMIN BUTTON ★★★★★1/2

(Century 16, Century 20) In early-century Louisiana an unusual child is born, looking like an old man and not expected to live. With the nurturing of boarding-house doyenne Queenie (Taraji P. Henson), baby Benjamin beats the odds and continues to thrive, appearing to grow younger as he ages. Benjamin's meeting with 7-year-old Daisy (Elle Fanning) has a profound effect on his life, her presence a stabilizing force that ebbs and flows throughout the years. Benjamin and the adult Daisy (Cate Blanchett) inexplicably meet halfway on the age spectrum — on her way to the golden years and his way to ultimate youth. *Rated: PG-13 for brief violence, sexual content and language. 2 hours, 47 minutes. — J.A.*

DOUBT ★★★★★

(Century 16, Century 20) There is no doubt that Philip Seymour Hoffman, Amy Adams and Viola Davis are the three best reasons to see John Patrick Shanley's adaptation of his Pulitzer Prize- and Tony Award-winning drama. Their nuanced, naturalistic performances help counter Meryl Streep's more mannered turn that rings so false at the end. Shanley's examination of moral issues is another reason to catch the battle between Sister Aloysius (Streep) and congenial Father Flynn (Hoffman), whom she suspects of pedophilia. No evidence exists that the priest has behaved inappropriately with the parochial school's first black student (Joseph Foster). The narrative construct teeters on the concept of reasonable doubt — and the blindness of those making unjustified accusations. Or are they? *Rated: PG-13 for thematic material. 1 hour. 44 minutes. — S.T.*

HE'S JUST NOT THAT INTO YOU ★★1/2

(Century 16, Century 20) Is he into you or not? That's the perennial question nagging this pithy romantic comedy that keeps its troubles airy and close to the surface. Based on the relationship book of the same name, "Just Not Into You" tangles its large cast of characters and storylines into virtual knots, then tries to unravel them with advice swapping and a kind of misery-loves-company pleasure. An if-beautiful-people-aren't-working-it-no-wonder-I'm-suffering-too kind of vibe. Playing a hopeless idealist, Ginnifer Goodwin is a surprising spark amidst the A-list cast that includes Jennifer Aniston and Ben Affleck. *Rated: PG-13 for language and sexual situations. 2 hours, 7 minutes. — J.A.*

RACE TO WITCH MOUNTAIN ★★

(Century 16, Century 20) Jack Bruno (Dwayne Johnson) is your typical misunderstood tough guy. After stints in prison, Jack is determined to tread the straight-and-narrow (although driving a cab in Sin City doesn't scream "do-gooder"). When young Sara (Robb) and her brother, Seth (Alexander Ludwig), hop in Jack's cab hoping for a ride, Jack reluctantly takes the fare. But Sara and Seth have a secret: They are extraterrestrials whose spaceship has crashed. The young siblings are being chased by

government spooks led by Henry Burke (Ciaran Hinds) An assassin from their home planet is also in hot pursuit. Sara and Seth are desperate to reacquire their ship being held in the Area 51-esque stronghold at Witch Mountain — and Jack gets to play chaperone. Johnson and Robb are worth the time, even if the script isn't out of this world. *Rated: PG for sequences of action and violence, frightening and dangerous situations, and some thematic elements. 1 hour, 39 minutes. — T.H.*

TWO LOVERS ★★★

(Aquarius) Joaquin Phoenix plays Leonard Kraditor, a thirtysomething New Yorker who lives and works with his parents (Moni Moshonov and Isabella Rossellini). Recent suicide attempts hover over Leonard, but he perks up when he meets Sandra Cohen (Vinessa Shaw), an attractive young woman who takes an obvious interest in him. Spurred on by her parents and his, the two strike up a relationship, but then Leonard meets Michelle Rausch (Gwyneth Paltrow), a stunning upstairs neighbor. Since Michelle's recklessness extends to dating a married man (Elias Koteas), Leonard becomes the pursuer rather than the pursued, and so he finds himself in a conundrum. Should Leonard love the one he's with, or win the one he loves? "Two Lovers" heartbreakingly explores our romantic delusions, and the

tragedy of always wanting more than we can have. *Rated: R for language, sexuality and brief drug use. 1 hour, 40 minutes. — P.C.*

WATCHMEN ★★1/2

(Century 16, Century 20) The year is 1985. Superheroes have been forced by the government to hang up their capes and cowls. The last of the hero groups has disbanded. Only the enigmatic and violent Rorschach (Jackie Earle Haley) refuses to abandon his crime-fighting lifestyle. Rorschach is determined to solve the mysterious homicide of fellow vigilante The Comedian (Jeffrey Dean Morgan), who is tossed from a high-rise by a shadowed assailant. As Rorschach investigates the brutal murder, other do-gooders are brought into the fold: the nearly omnipotent Dr. Manhattan (Billy Crudup); tough gal Silk Spectre (Malin Akerman), the sincere but soft Nite Owl (Patrick Wilson) and brilliant billionaire Ozymandias (Matthew Goode). "Watchmen" is a cinematic achievement that is certain to take on cult status — a superhero epic with guts. *Rated: R for strong graphic violence, sexuality, nudity and language. 2 hours, 43 minutes. — T.H.*
