From shifting thought to solid canvas

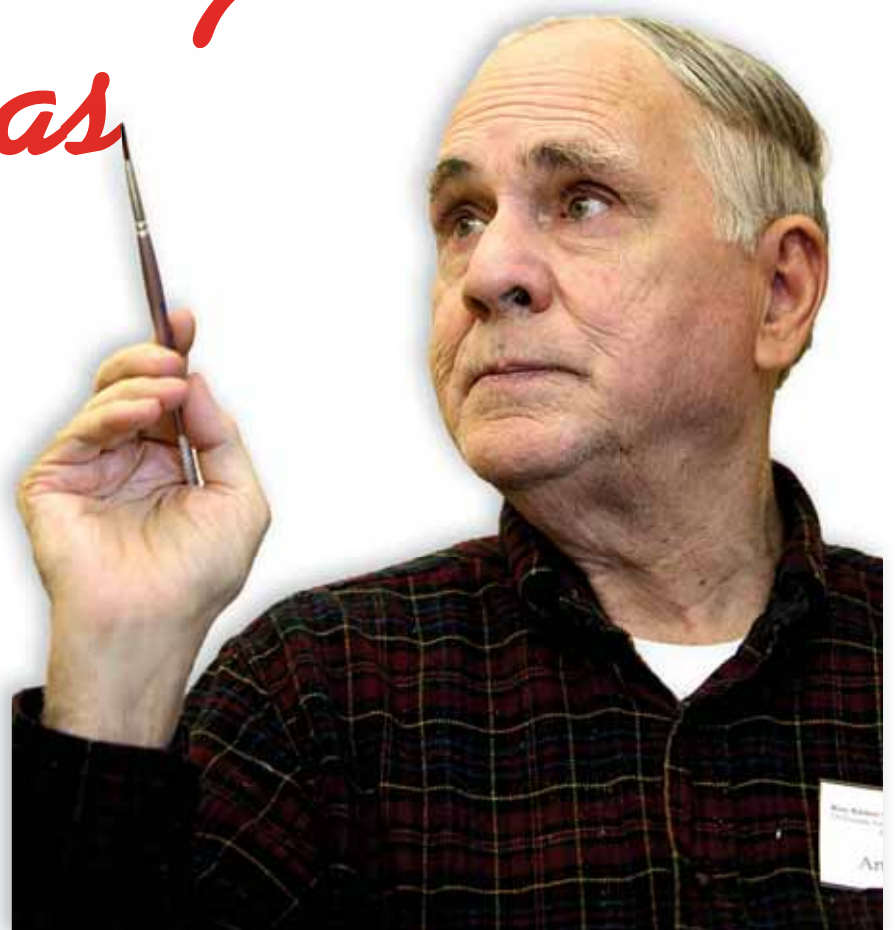
'MEMORY IN THE MAKING' CLASS AT AVENIDAS CENTER LETS ALZHEIMER'S PATIENTS COMMUNICATE THROUGH ART

Long before his fellow art students arrived, Art Pollard covered canvas after canvas with pictures of robins and hummingbirds.

The Sunnyvale resident, an Alzheimer's patient who participates in daytime programs at the Avenidas Senior Day Health Center, said robins are his favorite bird. But he also enjoys drawing the hummingbirds, which he remembers seeing frequently as a child.

Once a week Pollard, a 70-year-old military veteran, spends his afternoons painting with up to seven other patients as part of "Memory in the Making," an art program run by the Alzheimer's Association. The Avenidas Center, located on Escuela Avenue next to the Mountain View Senior Center, holds medical and social programs for senior

citizens throughout the day. But the art programs are specifically for participants with Alzheimer's and dementia, and allow them to communicate through their artwork.

"The participants use painting to express things they can't say," said Lenny Park, director of the Avenidas Senior Day Health Center.

"They don't have to be an art-

ist," he said. "Some people have never painted. They just sit down and do it. It's really special."

The Alzheimer's Association runs 30 similar programs

throughout the Peninsula, and volunteers lead participants in painting classes. Some of the students in other Bay Area classes have lost more of their communication skills, and the classes allow them to express themselves, according to Association spokesperson Patty Guinto.

Earlier this month, the Association auctioned off these pictures at a function held at the Computer

History Museum, raising an impressive sum — \$93,000 — for the classes and other programs.

The students in the Mountain View class are mostly higher functioning, said teacher Erin Morgan, who is pursuing a master's degree at Notre Dame University in Belmont.

"For these students it's more about the sensory experience," Morgan said.

As Pollard applies blue and brown paint to his canvas, he speaks of the robin he saw that very morning. Most of the students in the Mountain View class are able to explain the thought behind the art.

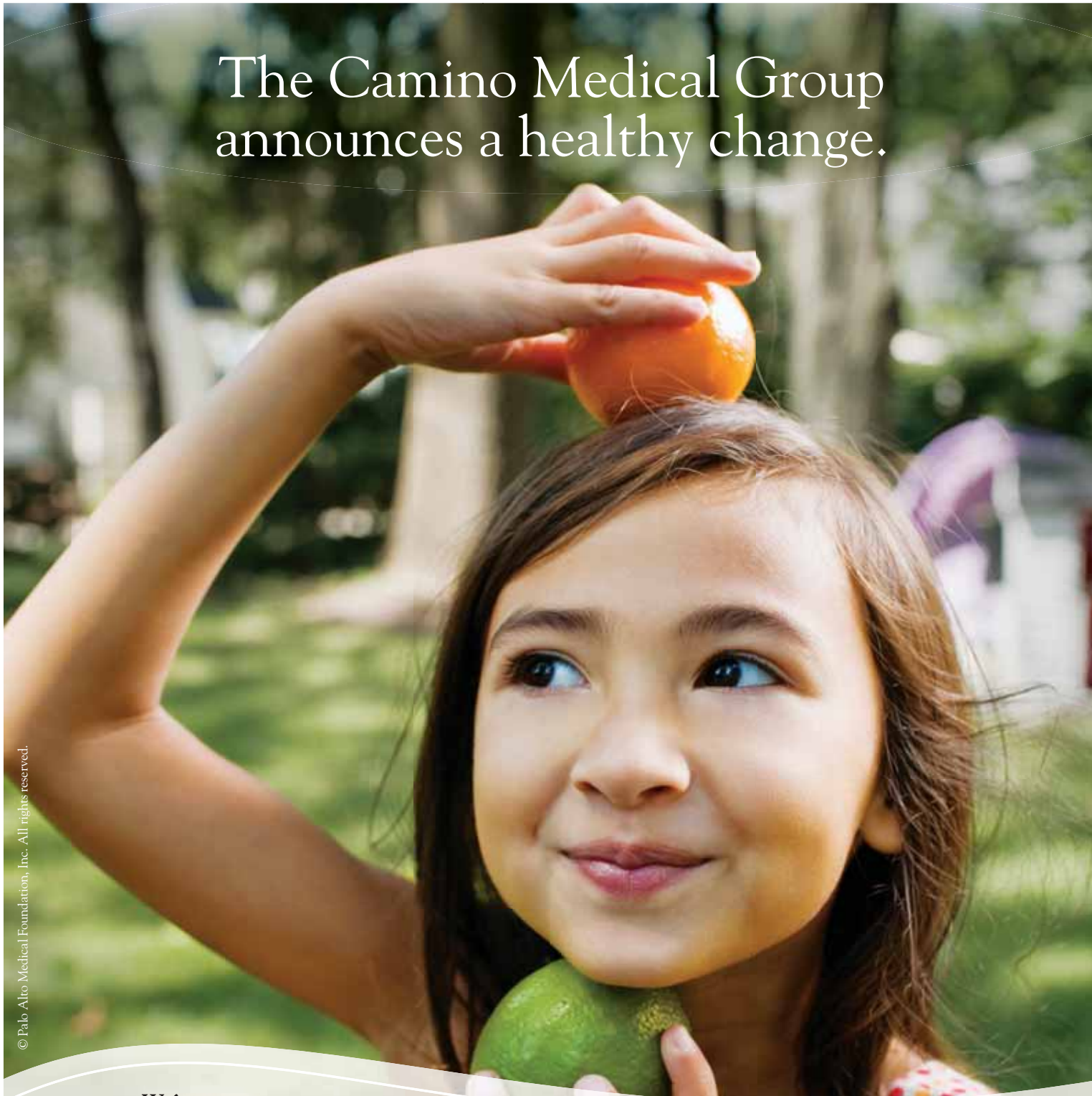
Inez Murillo, another student in the class, finished up drawing a doll last Wednesday after months of working on the same piece. Across the room, Felipe Garcia used a magnifying glass to sketch different shapes.

"He likes to have themes and boundaries," Morgan said of Garcia.

But for all of the students, she said, the art class gives them a rare opportunity to just paint. In their paintings, the artists are able to hold fast that most fleeting of things: memories. ▀

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Curbing seasonal allergies

Sneezing, a stuffy or runny nose and itchy eyes are the uncomfortable signs that allergy season is underway. Hay fever, also called allergic rhinitis, happens when your immune system overreacts to allergens found in the air you breathe.

Q: What's the worst season for allergy sufferers?

A: Seasonal allergies are typically caused by plant pollens, and different plants release pollen at different times of the year. This means that the worst season for an individual allergy sufferer depends on what plant pollens he or she is allergic to.

In our area, juniper, cedar and cypress tree pollens are at their height from late January to early March, followed by oak pollens in March, and walnut, olive and grass pollens in late spring. If your symptoms are worse during the later summer or fall, it could signal an allergy to weed pollens.

To determine what may be causing your seasonal allergies, ask your doctor or see an allergy specialist.

Q: What can I do to control my seasonal allergy symptoms without taking medication?

A: There are many steps you can take to ease your seasonal allergy symptoms:

■ Change your clothes and wash your hands after hiking to avoid bringing pollens into your home.

■ Cover your bed pillows with allergy-proof liners that go between your pillow and the regular pillow cover. During allergy season, common year-round allergens like the dust mites found in all bedding can make symptoms worse. A pillow liner will help reduce added irritation from dust mites.

■ Get rid of fabric couch pillows that can harbor allergens and dust mites. If you want pillows on your couch, choose leather or vinyl pillows.

■ Keep windows closed from sunrise to mid-morning as pollen levels peak in the morning.

■ Keep car windows up and use the "recirculate" air setting to keep pollen out of the car.

Q: What medications can help me control my allergies?

A: The most natural and effective medication you can

use to ease allergy symptoms is an over-the-counter saline nose rinse such as Ocean Mist or Simply Saline. These rinses flush allergens and other irritants out of the nose before they can cause allergy symptoms.

Conventional allergy medications such as Claritin and Zyrtec are safe, available without a prescription and can ease allergy symptoms within an hour of taking them. In addition, prescription cortisone nose sprays, such as Nasonex or Flonase, can prevent the allergic reaction that causes allergy symptoms in the first place. However, it may take anywhere between a week and three months before you notice the sprays working.

Be careful using complementary or alternative allergy treatments as some of these products can interfere with conventional medicines prescribed by your doctor. Unlike conventional medicines, alternative and complementary medicines have not been tested by the Food and Drug Administration, and their effectiveness is based only on anecdotal evidence. Some herbal remedies can also cause allergic reactions.

Q: Can allergy shots eliminate year-round allergy symptoms?

A: Allergy shots, in which a patient builds up an immunity by receiving a shot containing a tiny dose of the substance he or she is allergic to, can be effective at minimizing allergy symptoms. However, they are a major investment of time and money. Fortunately, most allergy sufferers don't need them and can get effective relief from a combination of saline nose rinses, allergy medications, cortisone nose sprays and home changes such as using allergy-proof pillow liners.

Patients who continue to suffer from chronic year-round allergies or have very bad seasonal allergies year after year, despite having tried all regular allergy treatments, should consider allergy shots. The shots need to be administered at the allergist's office, as there is a very small risk the shots could cause an allergic reaction severe enough to require immediate medical treatment. ■

(Century 16, Century 20) In the case of *Monsters v. Aliens* — henceforth to be referred to as "Monsters Vs. Aliens" — we find in favor of monsters. Said monsters are the heroes of the latest Dreamworks Animation release, rendered in CGI and presented in 3D. The parties involved in this sci-fi-themed action comedy include Susan Murphy (voiced by Reese Witherspoon), whose transformation into a 50-foot-tall woman (alias Ginormica) we witness. Murphy stipulates the existence of four other government-sequestered monsters: lagoon creature The Missing Link (Will Arnett), insectoid mad scientist Dr. Cockroach (Hugh Laurie), blob B.O.B. (Seth Rogen) and the Godzilla-meets-a-hamster creature Insectosaurus (who roars anonymously). This court ultimately finds in favor of those darn monsters. Especially that B.O.B., who has no brain, but affirms, "Turns out, you don't need one." Delightful! *Rated PG for sci-fi action, some crude humor and mild language. 1 hour, 34 minutes. P.C.*

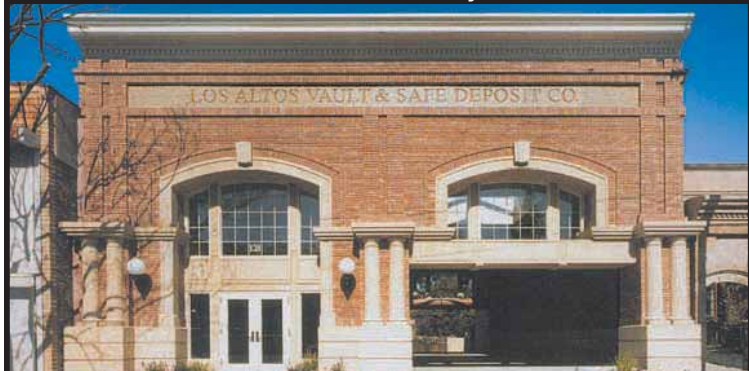

(Century 16, Century 20) Ronnie Barnhardt could be Paul Blart's sick-and-twisted brother. Both are mall cops who live with their mothers and have dreams of trading their security-guard badges for the real thing. But beneath his good-natured surface, Seth Rogen's lumbering Ronnie is a bipolar, delusional vigilante with visions of greatness. All he needs is a real case to prove himself — and some firearm power instead of being restricted to using tasers and mace. A flasher harassing women in the mall's parking lot provides the perfect opportunity. A comic conundrum, the movie feels fresh and unpredictable within its formulaic narrative. Adding a dark underbelly to the genre, the vulgarity has some redeeming value. But like the shopping-mall experience, "Observe and Report" isn't for everyone. *Rated: R for pervasive language, graphic nudity, drug use, sexual content and violence. 1 hour. 25 minutes.* — S.T.

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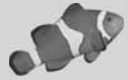

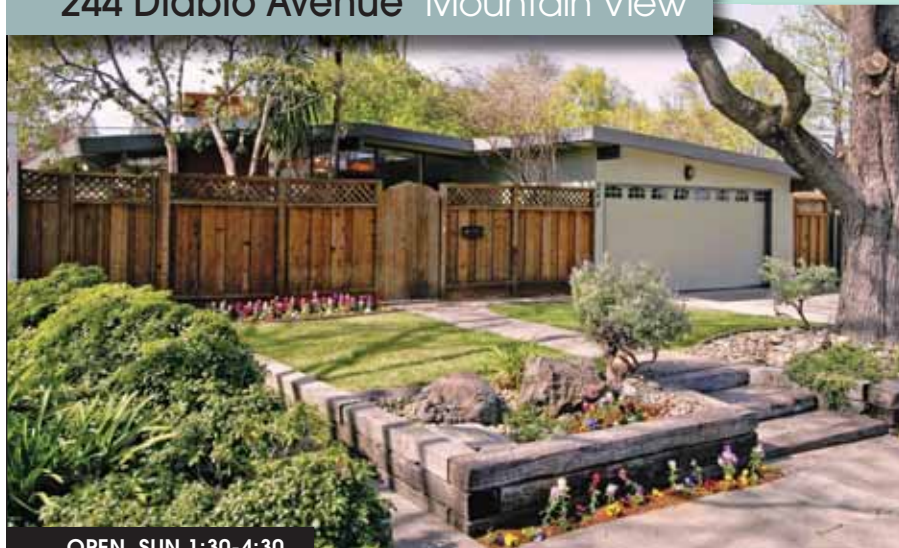
