'STAR TREK'

Unless you've been living under a rock, you've at least heard of "Star Trek." You probably recognize the odd phrase ("Beam me up," "Set phasers on stun" or perhaps "Live long and prosper") and the guy with the pointy ears.

Some of you recognize quite a bit more, and director J.J. Abrams and screenwriters Alex Kurtzman and Roberto Orci have effectively served both masters: The rebooted "Star Trek" will please the lion's share of fans while reaching out to what may be the biggest audience the 43-year-old series has ever enjoyed.

Abrams has taken essentially the same tack here as he did with Paramount's other big TV-derived franchise, "Mission: Impossible." Like Abrams' "Mission: Impossible III," "Star Trek" runs mostly on fast-paced, big-budgeted, explosive action, fuel-injected with melodrama. The bravura opening sequence immediately thrills and tugs at the heartstrings, but brush that tear from your eye, as Abrams is about to hurtle through and hurdle over enough scrapes for dozens of cliffhanger serials.

Abrams and company have achieved quite a bit in reframing the future adventures of the explorers of Starfleet (a "peacekeeping and humanitarian armada"). The crew of the Enterprise includes Capt. Christopher Pike (Bruce Greenwood), first officer Spock (Zachary Quinto), communications officer Uhura (Zoe Saldana),

Dr. Leonard "Bones" McCoy (Karl Urban), helmsman Hikaru Sulu (John Cho), 17-year-old navigator Chekov (Anton Yelchin), and the brash and unwelcome James T. Kirk (Chris Pine), destined to follow in his father's footsteps to become a Starfleet captain (also on the fringes: Simon Pegg's Scottish starship engineer Montgomery Scott).

Before the Enterprise takes its maiden voyage in response to a mysterious threat (involving Eric Bana's

Romulan "war criminal" Nero), Abrams gets to work with some surprisingly rich and certified-fresh myth-building. It's a stroke of genius to conceive of Kirk and Spock as two rebels looking for a cause, who butt heads on the way to becoming lifelong friends. The filmmakers fill the film with spectacular special effects and fan-pleasing in-jokes and references, including walking reference Leonard Nimoy reprising the role he created as the elder Spock (referred to in the credits as "Spock Prime").

No fair telling how or when he turns up, but I will say this: He comes along with one mother of a plot hole that's close to inexcusable (and definitely illogical). Abrams hopes he's got the film moving too fast for viewers to notice or care, and he's probably right.

'X-MEN ORIGINS: WOLVERINE'

Hugh Jackman has certainly earned his claws. The fourth film to see Jackman behind the growl of Marvel's popular anti-hero Wolverine aptly spotlights both the charismatic actor and the no-nonsense character that made his career. And a superbly cast Liev Schreiber (as the vicious Sabretooth) helps offset the film's hodgepodge plot and barrage of obscure characters.

The story focuses on the relationship between brothers Wolverine (aka Logan) and Sabretooth (aka

When former members of Stryker's squad start getting assassinated—and Kayla is thrown in harm's way—Wolverine agrees to undergo a procedure (at Stryker's request) that will lace his bones with adamantium, a nigh-indestructible metal.

Never trust the government. It turns out Stryker has sinister intentions, and Wolverine is fortunate to survive the adamantium infusion. As Wolverine endeavors to dismantle Stryker's nefarious program, he turns to fellow mutants for help, including Cajun-born card shark Remy Lebeau (Taylor Kitsch), aka Gambit, and teleporter John Wraith (musician Will.i.am). Meanwhile, Sabretooth is eager for a brotherly scrap with Wolverine and never seems far from the action.

Jackman and Schreiber are so well cast and so sharp in their roles

that extraneous missteps almost feel excusable. Sure, Jackman could sleepwalk through his part after perfectly portraying the feral hero in three previous films, but Schreiber was a question mark, yet nearly steals the show with his fanged snarls and wolfish movement. Kitsch is also terrific as Gambit, though his New Orleans accent seems to waver at times.

But "Wolverine" is not without its problems. The filmmakers stray from the character's comic book origin too much—apparently a result of character overload—and the film lulls in the second act. There's also a sense of lost opportunity, from both storytelling and visual standpoints. In the comics, Wolverine and Deadpool have impressive-looking

Victor Creed), from their adolescence to wartime heroics to involvement in the controversial Weapon X program. After being sacrificed to a firing squad (an experience that "ticked," Logan says), Wolverine and Sabretooth are approached by General William Stryker (Danny Huston). Stryker convinces the men to join a team of tough mutants that includes sharpshooter Agent Zero (Daniel Henney), brawler Fred Dukes (Kevin Durand) and wise-cracking mercenary Wade Wilson (Ryan Reynolds), aka Deadpool.

But Stryker's band is decidedly ruthless, and Wolverine resigns (much to the dismay of Sabretooth). Flash forward: Wolverine is living the mountaineer life in the woods of Canada, earning money as a lumberjack and enjoying a romance with school teacher Kayla Silverfox (Lynn Collins).

Those wanting to excuse the plot hole can tie it into the film's strong sense of destiny, despite the villain's largely successful attempts to disrupt the timeline.

Speaking of quibbles, here are three others: the unearned, campy touch of putting some kind of space sword in Sulu's hand; the hellishly spiky and impractically designed Romulan technology ("Star Trek" bad guys never met a catwalk they didn't like); and, after

a while, that relentlessly manic action-movie pace. At times, you may wish, as I did, that this most dizzyingly hyperactive of movies would calm down just a little.


The rest of the strenuous plot gymnastics pretty much work, and by pressing the continuity-reset button, Abrams and company are able to make some bold — in fact, downright apocalyptic — changes to the "Star Trek" universe. But change is good for the soul, they say, and the new cast members acquit themselves admirably by channeling their forebears without suffocating their own personalities. ▣

outfits that could translate well to the big screen in the hands of a gifted costume designer, but the filmmakers take the easy route. Movies such as "Spider-Man," "The Dark Knight" and "Watchmen" have adapted their title characters' costumes — so why not "Wolverine"?

Overall, the movie is not unlike the character himself: Rough around the edges but memorable nonetheless. ▣
